
What is a "Hybrid" Meeting?

A meeting that combines elements of a live, onsite meeting along with a remote meeting environment, in a way that is compelling for all parties.

This allows for maximum participation and engagement in club meetings by providing flexible options for members, which is especially important during these challenging times.

What equipment do you need?







Laptop + Connections







- A suitably powered laptop to run Zoom w/Internet connection (Minimum Intel I5 & 8GB RAM recommended)
- A USB Hub to expand the number of available USB connections. Around \$10 on Amazon. https://www.amazon.com/dp/B00JX1ZS50/ref=cm_sw_em_r_mt_dp_pqilFbE2DRDJ5
- Two (2) USB 2.0 or 3.0 extension cables (16' recommended) to connect Webcam and Speakerphone to PC. Around \$9 each on Amazon. https://www.amazon.com/dp/B00B5TEJI4/ref=cm_sw_em_r_mt_dp_mrilFbF6BR3D6

Projection Screen



- Projector and screen (or a white wall).
- Video Connectors (HDMI or VGA) from PC to projector.
- Remote participants will be projected on the screen.



Note: The Jabra 410 ranges in price. Current \$139.99 on Amazon (sold through Jabra) but can be purchased on eBay or through local sellers (Facebook Marketplace) as low as \$50. Other speakerphone options are available as well, but Jabra 410 or 510 are both very good.

Tripod and Phone/Tablet



- Tripod w/phone holder positioned near podium or stage and with camera facing the audience.
- Phone/Tablet Bring your own. Any newer iPhone or Android tablet.
- The Zoom app needs to be running on the phone and connected to the Zoom meeting. Be careful to have enough battery power for meeting (or have it plugged in).
- Prices vary but numerous good options around \$20-\$30.

Hybrid Meetings on a budget!

To convert our club from an Onsite only option to a Hybrid model, we only needed the following equipment.

Equipment List	Cost
HD Webcam w/table tripod	\$36.18
Jabra 410 Speakerphone	\$59.80
2 x USB Extension Cables (16')	\$18.82
Tripod w/phone holder	\$22.99
4 Port USB Hub	\$ 7.99
Surge Protector Power Strip	<u>\$11.00</u>
Total	\$156.78

Note: Our projector and screen come with the room we use at New Life Church, and we are using our donated laptop (or one of our personal laptops). Costs for these items is much higher, of course.



Contingency Plans

When dealing with technology, problems will arise from time to time. Preparation and flexibility are the key to handling these challenges!

Situation	Resolution
No Internet/WIFI in room?	Bring a MIFI device or use a phone Hotspot!
Primary laptop/PC goes down	Have a 2 nd laptop as a backup.
Webcam doesn't work	Use Zoom on an iPhone, iPad or Android
Speakerphone doesn't work	Have a backup microphone or dial into Zoom via a cell phone and use Speaker mode.
A remote speaker loses Internet or is dropped from Zoom.	Be prepared to move on to the next speaker and adjust schedule accordingly
Power goes out / Nothing is working	Use Cell phones and/or iPads in battery mode and make the best of it!

Pros and Cons

Pros	Cons
Gives members flexibility and choice.	Requires extra time for setup & breakdown.
Increases the reach of membership.	Moving & storing equipment.
Low relative cost of setup.	Murphy's Law (see contingencies)
No excuses to not attend.	Training & practice are needed.
