D54 is seeking a Club Extension Chair. This position, along with all the job descriptions, are posted on the D54 website. Club Extension Report

D54 currently has a base of 50 clubs and we currently have 47 paid clubs. 50 clubs are necessary for our district to be distinguished, 51 clubs to be select distinguished, 52 clubs to be Presidents Distinguished, and 53 to be Smedley Distinguished. According to TI, D54 needs to have 60 paid clubs by June 30, 2024, to maintain our independent district status.

According to TI, D54 has a new club chartering in Freeport, Illinois at Jo Carroll Energy. Unfortunately, this club is not responsive to our calls and emails.

D54 Storytelling club is on hold. We need 7 experienced Toastmasters to volunteer to attend 3 launch meetings to get started. Please contact Wendy Pesavento to volunteer. Patrick, Cece, and Bonnie have agreed to help. We only need 4 more volunteers.

D54 received 0 leads this month from TI.

Club Retention Report - Tom Willison, DTM, PDG

D54 starts this TI year with a payment base of 1557 members, D54 needs 1573 member payments to be Distinguished, 1604 to be Select Distinguished, 1635 to be Presidents Distinguished, and 1682 to be Smedley Distinguished. We currently have 796 payments. We have 6 clubs at charter strength or above. 18 clubs that fall into the 13-19-member range. We have 16 clubs that have 8-12 members. We have 7 club with 0-7 members.

Our goal is to help every club earn DCP goal 7 (four new members) and goal 8 (four more new members). One way to do this is with a plan. Many clubs have already submitted their club success plans to their AD's.

Corporate Relations Report

Julia Has who has volunteered to support the district as our Corporate Relations Chair. Currently Julia is working on a lead we received for a new corporate club in Manteno.

Prison Club Report – Jon Greiner, DTM
