All of our courses are offered with the full-time student in mind. Anyone who is planning to attend LBC only one or two years should make certain that the courses he/she wishes to take will be offered during the time he/she plans to attend. LBC cannot assume the responsibility to offer specific courses for students who plan to attend for only a short time.

All courses will be graded in the following manner for the students' final grade:

20% - attendance
20% - classroom grades (includes quizzes, papers, projects, midterm, etc)
20% - Christian Service
40% - Final Exam

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

1. LBC believes it is necessary to dress appropriately and modestly at all times. It is the school's firm belief that Christian men and women should dress, look, and act differently than the world. One's outward appearance is a reflection of the condition of the heart and mind. Students of LBC are not isolated from the world; but hopefully are insulated as they live in the world. Those preparing for the ministry must be above reproach in their Christian life and be clean vessels worthy of the Master's use.

2. Men are required to wear dress shirt, tie, and slacks to all classes. All shirts must be tucked in and have a collar. Hair should be well groomed and not fashioned after the world.
3. Women are required to wear knee length dresses or skirts to classes. Apparel for women must not fit tightly.
4. Extreme fads of any nature are not allowed, Anything the administration considers being a fad or extreme will not be permitted. The administration reserves the right to determine if dress or appearance is not appropriate.
5. If a man must come straight from work to class, he may wear his work clothing to class. It is best for him and the classmates, if at all possible, to wear the required attire for class. We are flexible with the students under certain conditions.
6. Students must be members of a local church that is in complete accordance with our statement of faith and must attend his or her church services. Students moving into the area to attend Lighthouse Baptist College will be required to attend Lighthouse Baptist Church.

COURSE CREDIT POLICY

Credit will be given for a course completed within the curriculum major and providing there is a passing grade. All Bible classes are 2 credit hours.

CLASS ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance at class is required. A student is responsible for all work assigned, including any assignments missed because of absences. A student should consult his instructor in advance about work to be missed because of a foreseeable absence. Punctual attendance is expected to all classes. Three (3) tardies will equal one absence. Students will be excused from class to allow for participation in approved college functions as determined by the Pastor. Students missing class because of such activities are responsible for the material given during the class. Arrangements must be made for early submission of assignments due on day(s) of his or her absence. Makeup scheduled tests or quizzes should be coordinated with the appropriate instructor and will be taken prior to the scheduled date whenever possible. Absences for these functions are not counted against the student's record for the semester. Classes are held Monday night from 6:00-9:00. Wednesday night church attendance is mandatory for all students.

CHAPEL ATTENDANCE

Chapel attendance is required of all students as an integral part of his or her training.

CHRISTIAN SERVICE

We believe to better prepare for the ministry, it is important for the student to serve Christ while attending college. Therefore, all students will be required to participate in some type of Christian service every semester. This would include ministries such as Care Team, Nursing Home, Soul-Winning, Choir, Visitation, etc. The ministry is to be a continuous activity throughout the entire semester. We encourage you to get involved in a different ministry each semester to get a better understanding of how the ministries work. At the end of each semester, you will be required to turn in a Christian Service Report. This report is to be completed by the director of that ministry.

REASONS FOR DISMISSAL

1. A student who becomes vocally non-compliant with LBC's statement of beliefs.
2. A student who has excessive absences (as determined by the Pastor) during a semester term. The student will be allowed to return the next term, but the entire course must be repeated.
3. A student caught cheating will be dismissed for the school term. The student will be allowed to return the next school term if repentant after having received counsel from the governing body. If a second offense occurs, the student will be dismissed permanently.
4. A student who fails to pay tuition up-to-date within one month after mid-term or final exams.
5. A student who becomes non-compliant with standards of conduct for LBC students will be dismissed if there is a refusal to become compliant.

FEES

Registration / Books - \$100 / semester

Tuition \$300 / semester

Total Fees per semester: \$400.00

Full payment for each semester is expected at the time of registration. If a student is unable to pay the full amount, he/she will make monthly payments starting in the Fall. Students are required to provide banking account information so that the tuition can be drafted from the account on the 15th of each month. The cost for both semesters will be broken into twelve (12) monthly payments, starting in October and ending in September of the following year. Please note that fees are subject to change at the discretion of the Pastor.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

High School students can begin to earn college credits during their Senior Year. Students are required to attend class weekly, submit all assignments, and take exams. The cost for LCS Seniors is \$255.00 per semester. Non LCS Seniors pay regular tuition price.

Students in 9th- 11th grade may attend class as auditing students. These students are not required to turn in assignments or take tests. The cost for High School Students to audit classes is \$100 per semester.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Any student interested in attending LBC should obtain an Application for Admission from the school office. If the prospective student is a member of a church other than Lighthouse, he/she is required to have his/her Pastor submit a Pastor Recommendation Form. All students must have a General Recommendation Form submitted. Applications for Admission are due at least three (3) weeks before the start of a semester. After review and acceptance of the application, the student may register for classes. All parts of the application (Pastor Recommendation- if needed, General Recommendation, and application fee) must be submitted before the application can be reviewed. The prospective student will be notified through letter of admission to LBC.
