Compatibility


- The compatibility of two or more compounds or substances to be placed in contact or close proximity to one another without detrimental effects on either


Glazing

The Façade

- The addition of insulation outbound is driven by integrity of existing façade, cost, and disruption to interior usage.
- Future building envelope retrofit efforts may lean towards over-cladding in buildings where the structural integrity of the existing façade is not in question.















Thermal Environmental Chamber

- 240 Data Acquisition channels 120 in each "room"
- PID Feedback Loop Light Rack Custom designed to provide more BTUs than the harshest thermal radiation on earth. (200 BTU/ ft^2)
- Pressure Differential +/- 1200 Pascals (25 PSF)
- Temperature Differential -4 to 150 F
- Humidity Control 10-95% RH
- Rain Water Simulation- 5 g/hr/ft^2 (~200 g/hr)











Owens Community College Perrysburg, OH

- Overclad of their administration building
- Condensation issue of the brick shelf penetrating thermal barrier
- Solution: Lightweight insulated veneer and EIFS










Parking Structure



90 ft²/gal	17	Broadcast 25 to 50 mesh silica sand at a rate of 7 lb per 100 ft $^{\circ}$ into wet primer.			
26 ft ^a /gal	60	Allow 45 minutes to cure before proceeding.			
90 ft ^e /gal	17	Broadcast slica sand or color quartz to refusal into wet TC. Allow 45 minutes to cure before proceeding.			
64 ft²/gal	25	Absent of aggregate. Allow 45 minutes to cure before opening to traffic.			


