

- Generally three main requirements for a public private partnership










I-75 Innovation Corridor

Cincinnati-Dayton Metroplex

- Projected that within the next decade that Cincinnati and Dayton will be recognized as one metropolitan statistical area (MSA)
- Largest MSA in Ohio
- 18th largest MSA in the U.S.
- Greater exposure to companies looking to relocate from other states and countries
- More opportunities for federal designations, federal funding, and economic development opportunities

- A co-branding initiative currently being led by TechSolve, Butler Tech, Cincinnati State,
 Princeton School District, and Red Tiger Innovation
- High concentration of leading advanced manufacturing, technology, healthcare and research facilities along the corridor

Future Ready Skills Force


Workforce Development

- A skilled workforce and shovel ready sites are the top two criteria when technology companies look to locate to an area


