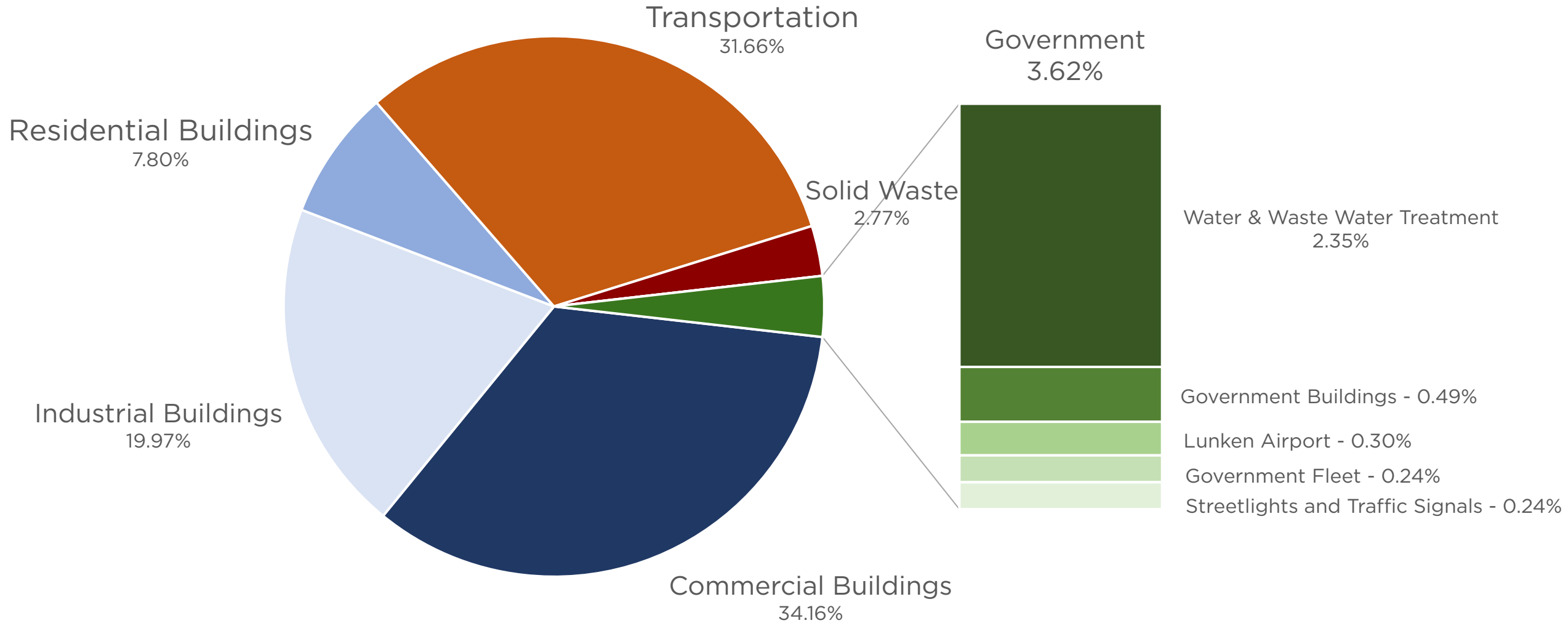




Cincinnati Carbon Profile

- We strive to provide experiences to interact with the ideas of our time, leading with integrity and transparency as we address the health of our living planet in the context of an art center.



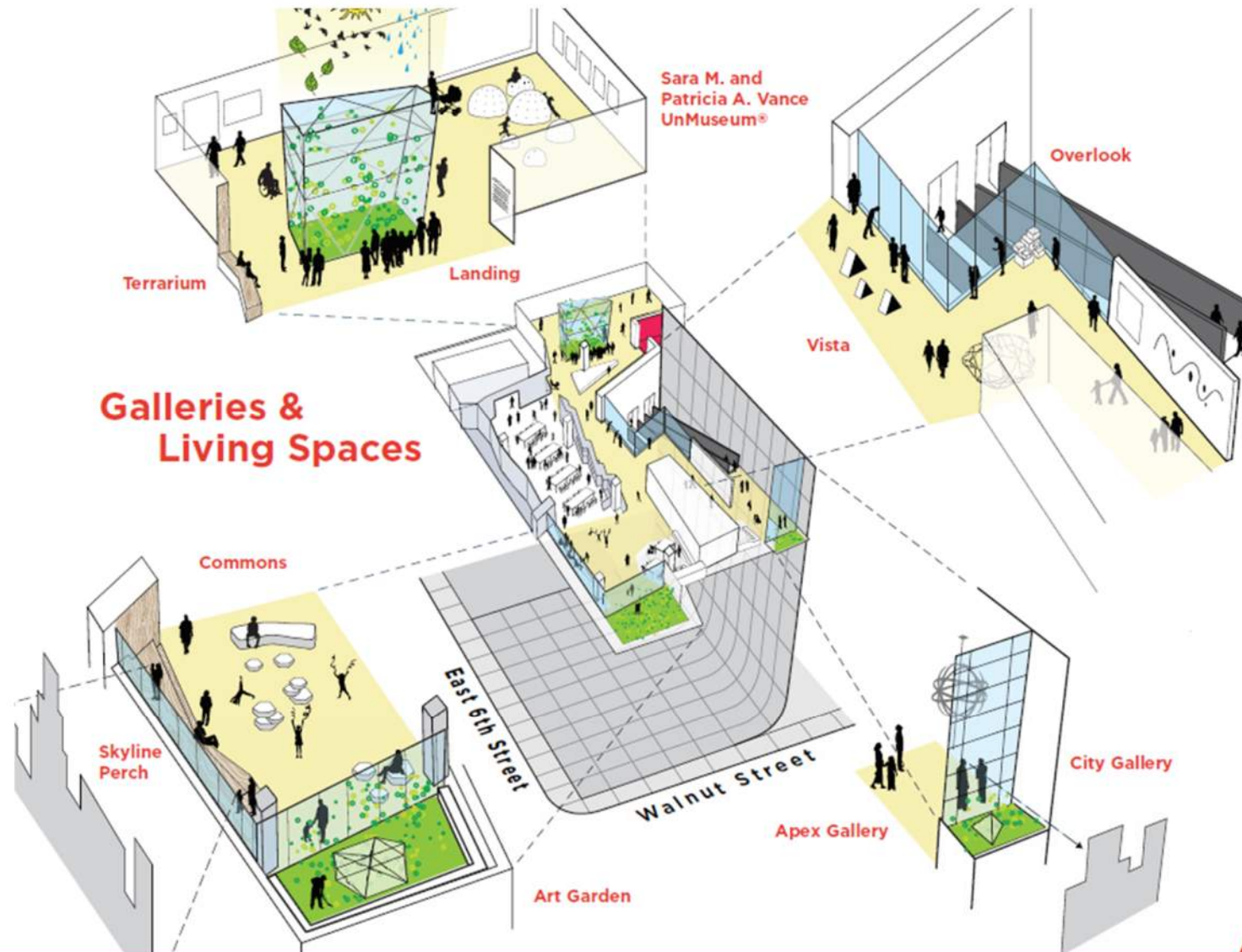

CAC FACILITY



- The CAC has 86,500 total square footage.
- LED lighting throughout the building.
- Electric energy is supplied by wind energy.
- Purchase chilled water from a central local plant.
- 95% of cleaning chemicals used are Green and LEED certified.
- 90% of paper products are Green certified.
- All paper and soap dispensers are Green certified.
- Most comprehensive mixed recycling program available through Rumpke.
- We partner with GoZero to compost all food waste produced from our new café, Fausto.
- Eliminated single-use plastics in the café and in our meetings and events.
