There are 3 ways of pronouncing S at the end of a word in English. The pronunciation of words ending in S depends on the final consonant sound.

- Sibilant Sound -
- = a hissing or buzzing sound.
- Voiceless Sound -
- = the vocal cords do not vibrate.
- Voiced Sound uses the vocal cords and they produce a vibration

or humming sound in the throat.
