ANNIVERSARY



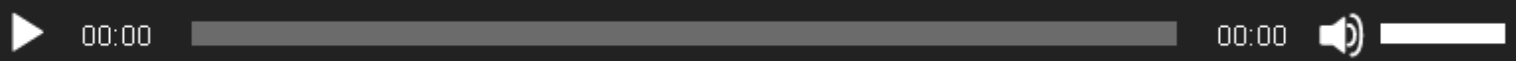
An anniversary is the date on which an event took place or an institution was founded in a previous year, and may also refer to the commemoration or celebration of that event.

BIRTHDAY

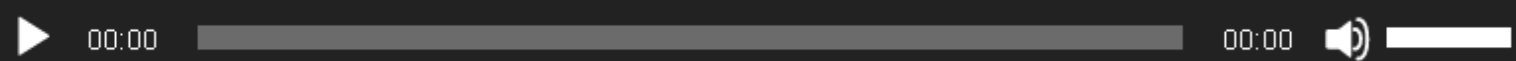
