### Take these steps to make your home safer:

- 1 Store firearms securely: Use a gun safe or lock to make firearms inaccessible to those at risk.
- ① Store ammunition and firearms separately: storing the ammunition in a separate location from the firearm is recommended.
- Use gun locks: A trigger or cable lock is an effective layer of security for any firearm.
- Remove firearms from the home during times of crisis: Temporarily removing firearms when someone is experiencing emotional distress or suicidal thoughts is a proven life-saving strategy.

The free gun lock is a simple and practical tool to help you secure firearms immediately. Wait until you feel confident you can keep yourself safe to handle a firearm. - Use a prescription lock: Store medications in a lockbox or secure cabinet to limit access.
- **Monitor quantities:** Regularly check for missing pills or signs of misuse.
