

### HOW TO DRESS FOR NATURE SCHOOL (WHEN IT'S COLD AND/OR WET!)

To ensure your child is warm, dry, and happy outdoors, please take a look at our recommended 1-2-3-4 layering system. If you have any questions or need help obtaining clothing, let us know!

## Layer 1: BASE LAYER

This layer is closest to your child's skin and should be slim fitting. Wool, wool blends, silk, or synthetic materials like polyester are recommended. Cotton is NOT recommended as it absorbs moisture and is a poor insulator. Socks should be tall (no ankle or cotton socks!)






## Layer 2: MID LAYER

This looser fitting layer adds a cozy insulating layer over top of the base layers. We recommend fleece or wool - a pair of pant bottoms and a pullover or zip up top work great. Add a fleece or down vest over top on those extra cold days.

## Layer 3: OUTER LAYER

WINTER: Snow pants/snow suits and boots should be insulated and waterproof. For cold, DRY days, down filled or synthetic jackets are best. For cold, WET days, an insulated waterproof jacket (like a ski jacket) is best.





# Layer 4: ACCESSORIES WINTER: Mittens/gloves should be insulated and waterproof and have

WINTER: Mittens/gloves should be insulated and waterproof and have a long, over sized cuff to fit OVER coat sleeves. For extra cold days, a thin pair of wool, fleece, or synthetic gloves can be worn underneath them. Fleece or wool hats, neckies/ balaclavas are recommended.

SPRING: Waterproof rain mittens (lined or unlined) and rain hats
