I do avow and solemnly declare that I will abide by the following regulations in order that I may be part of the SMRID Aquatic Invasive Species Program and ensure that invasive species do not enter the SMRID waterways

- I do understand that the 40 Mile Reservoir, Sherburne (Grassy) Lake, Stafford Lake, Chin and Sauder Reservoir are owned and operated by the SMRID and as such they control activities around and on the reservoir.
- I understand the policy and legislation in Alberta for Aquatic Invasive Species, particularly the "Pull the Plug", mandatory Reporting and non-release of subject water sections of the Alberta Fisheries (Ministerial) Regulations.
- I have not taken my boat out of Alberta; if I have done so I have had the boat inspected by the Government of Alberta since my return into Alberta.
- While I have my boat sticker I will not take my boat out of Alberta and will remove the sticker if I ever take my boat out of province.
- I understand that if I do not abide by the above that I could be forbidden from boating on reservoirs and lakes owned by the SMRID.
