

Flexible Cystoscopy at Collins Urology

Examination of the urethra and bladder is a common urological procedure to check the health of the lower urinary tract in women and men. Currently this procedure is usually done in a hospital operating theatre, but with the recent advancement in Ambu-scope technology, Collins Urology can now offer cystoscopy examination in the rooms. In rooms cystoscopy is done using a single use, new technology, flexible camera. This means every examination is done with a brand-new scope which ensures complete safety without deterioration in camera quality. Rather than being admitted to hospital for a number of hours to undergo this short examination, the in rooms flexible cystoscopy is a "walk-in-walk-out" procedure that will take around 20 minutes. This will allow minimal disruption to your daily activities while allowing an important assessment of the urinary tract to be undertaken. The cystoscopy is performed by Dr Collins with a nurse in attendance. To minimise discomfort, local anaesthetic gel is placed into the urethra (the water pipe from the bladder that you pass urine through) before commencing the examination. No needle injections are required, and the procedure rarely causes more than minor discomfort. You will be able to drive home after the cystoscopy with no limitation in activities.
