



THE POMPIER LADDER

The "pompier ladder" (pronounced pom—peer) is probably named for French fire-fighters known as "Pompier" (pronounced pom-pee-yay). It is reported as "invented" by a St. Louis Lieutenant named Christ Hoell. In some fire departments across the country, it also became known as the "Hoell Rescue Device."


