Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

This Code of Conduct outlines the standards of behaviour expected from all members of CASA España.

2. Core Principles

Members are expected to:

- Act with respect, integrity, and inclusivity
 - Promote a positive supporter culture
 - Represent CASA España and Charlton Athletic in a responsible manner

3. Expected Behaviour

Members must:

- Treat others fairly and without discrimination
 - Respect differing opinions
 - Behave responsibly at events and online
 - Follow local laws and venue rules

4. Unacceptable Behaviour

The following will not be tolerated:

- Discrimination (race, gender, nationality, etc.)
 - Harassment or abuse (verbal or physical)
 - Hate speech or offensive content
 - Bringing the Association into disrepute

5. Events & Matchdays

Members attending events or watch parties must:

- Respect venues, staff, and other supporters
 - Avoid excessive or disruptive behaviour
 - Follow organiser instructions

6. Social Media Conduct

- Represent CASA España positively online
 - Avoid abusive or inflammatory posts
 - Respect Charlton Athletic, opponents, and officials

7. Breaches & Disciplinary Action

If a member breaches this Code:

- A warning may be issued
 - Membership may be suspended
 - Membership may be terminated in serious cases

8. Reporting Concerns

Members can report concerns confidentially to the committee.
