MARRIAGE LICENSE PROCESS (OHIO)



1. BEFORE THE CEREMONY

- You must obtain a valid Ohio marriage license from the probate court.
- The license is typically valid for 60 days.
- Bring the license with you on the day of the ceremony.



The ceremony cannot be performed without the license.



2. DURING THE CEREMONY

- The officiant will perform the ceremony.
- No specific wording is required by the State of Ohio.
- The ceremony may be customized to your preferences.



3. AFTER THE CEREMONY

- The officiant will complete the required section of the marriage license, including:
 - ✓ Date of the ceremony
 - ✓ Location of the ceremony
 - ✓ Officiant's name and title
 - ✓ Officiant's signature



4. RETURNING THE LICENSE

- The completed license must be returned to the probate court that issued it.
- This must be done within 30 days of the ceremony.



- ✓ In most cases, the officiant will return the license.
- ✓ If arrangements are made for the couple to return it, it should be done promptly.



5. IMPORTANT NOTES

- No witnesses are required in the State of Ohio.
- Once filed, the marriage becomes officially recorded by the court.
- Certified copies of the marriage certificate can be requested from the probate court.
