Main Events

Music throughout town at your location plus **Native Plant Society – Tonkawa Chapter Native Plant Sale** at Barrow's beside the creek, **BBQ Cook-Off Cancer Fund Raiser** up and down Main Street, and **Environmental Fair** on the Civic Center grounds. In addition, we plan to ask *Dessert Food Trucks* to be located near the BBQ locations.

How will the Salado Porch and Planet Festival work?

Businesses along the streets of Salado are encouraged to host a musician on their front porches, stoops, yards, or driveways of their business. Businesses are encouraged to hire a performer throughout the day at various times from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. *whenever time you prefer*.
