

MVAHC Simple to Sew Face Mask



What you will need:

- Cotton fabric, a pretty print is best
- Rope elastic, beading cord eleastic, 1/8" flat elastic
- Cut the elastic 7" long

You can make two sizes: Adult or Child

- Put right sides of cotton and jersey fabric together.
 Cut 9 x 6 (Adult) or 8 x 5 (Child)
- 2. Starting at the center of the bottom edge, sew to the front corner, stop. Sew the elastic with the edge out into the corner, a few stiches forward and back will hold this.
- Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of the same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.
- 4. Now sew across the top of the mask to the next corner. Again put the elastic with the edge out.
- 5. Sew to the next corner and sew in the other end of the same elastic.
- 6. Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5"- 2" open. Stop, cut the tread. Turn inside out.
- 7. Pin 2 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are the same direction.
- Sew around the edge of the mask twice.Be sure any fabric design is faced horizonal.
