



MVAHC Simple to Sew Face Mask



What you will need:

- Cotton fabric, a pretty print is best
- Rope elastic, beading cord eleastic, 1/8" flat elastic
- Cut the elastic 7" long

You can make two sizes: Adult or Child

1. Put right sides of cotton and jersey fabric together.
Cut 9 x 6 (Adult) or 8 x 5 (Child)
2. Starting at the center of the bottom edge, sew to the front corner, stop. Sew the elastic with the edge out into the corner, a few stiches forward and back will hold this.
3. Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of the same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.
4. Now sew across the top of the mask to the next corner. Again put the elastic with the edge out.
5. Sew to the next corner and sew in the other end of the same elastic.
6. Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5"- 2" open. Stop, cut the tread. Turn inside out.
7. Pin 2 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are the same direction.
8. Sew around the edge of the mask twice.
Be sure any fabric design is faced horizontal.
