

OUTDOOR EXPLORERS - Terms & Conditions and Waiver of Liability

Thank you for joining us at Outdoor Explorers. We're so pleased to welcome you and your child to our nature-based sessions. Please take a few moments to read the following information carefully — it's here to ensure a shared understanding and safe, enjoyable experience for everyone involved.

1. Voluntary Assumption of Risk

Outdoor play and exploration come with inherent risks. These may include minor scrapes, insect bites, trips, or more serious incidents. By participating, you acknowledge and accept these risks for yourself and your child. All activities are designed with care, but risks may arise from the natural environment, other participants, or unexpected events. You are responsible for ensuring your child only takes part in activities that match their age and ability.

2. First Aid Consent

A trained First Aider is present at each session. In the unlikely event of an accident or medical issue, you consent to your child receiving basic first aid and, if necessary, being transported for further medical attention. We will contact you immediately in such an event.

3. Clothing & Equipment

Please ensure your child arrives in appropriate clothing for outdoor play (e.g. weatherproof layers, wellies, sun hats, etc.). Outdoor Explorers cannot accept responsibility for discomfort or injuries resulting from unsuitable clothing or footwear.

4. Weather & Session Changes

Our sessions run in most weather conditions, celebrating all seasons. However, in extreme or unsafe weather, we may need to cancel or adapt the session. You will be notified as soon as possible if any changes occur.

5. Personal Belongings

We encourage you to bring only essentials to each session. Outdoor Explorers cannot be held responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen belongings.

6. Parental Supervision

Our sessions are co-play opportunities, not childcare. Parents and carers remain fully responsible for their children's safety, supervision, and engagement throughout the session.

7. Photography Consent

We occasionally take photographs to celebrate learning moments, document experiences, and share the joy of our sessions on our website, social media, or promotional materials.

Please indicate your consent via the book when booking page by selecting one of the following:

- Yes, I consent to photos being taken and shared for the above purposes.
- No, I do not wish for my child to appear in any photography.

We always prioritise the dignity, safety, and privacy of every child.

8. Refund & Cancellation Policy

We understand that sometimes plans change.

- Parent cancellations: Refunds cannot be guaranteed for non-attendance.
 However, if you notify us at least 48 hours in advance, we may offer a credit towards a future session (subject to availability).
- Weather cancellations: If we cancel a session due to extreme weather or unforeseen circumstances, we will offer a full refund or a place on an alternative date.
- Sibling discounts are available but non-refundable if one child does not attend

9. Release of Liability

By attending, you agree to release Outdoor Explorers and its organisers, staff, volunteers, and landowners from any and all liability related to participation in sessions, including injuries, accidents, losses or damage, to the fullest extent allowed by law. This release also covers any medical professionals present. It is binding for you, your heirs, and representatives.

By reading this document, you confirm that:

- You have read, understood, and agreed to the terms above.
- You voluntarily accept responsibility for your child's participation.
- You release Outdoor Explorers from liability as outlined.
- You have indicated your decision regarding photography consent.
