Take part in training where you will learn how to **SAVE** someone from an unintentional, life-threatening poisonings related to the ingestion of opioids.

If you are concerned about a friend, family member or an associate with an opioid use disorder, this training is for you.

Naloxone is a prescription medication that reverses the affects of an opioid overdose. Participants who successfully complete the training will receive a **FREE** Naloxone kit via mail or scheduled pick up time.
