

# Your Cabin \_



## The BBQ

To run the BBQ, make sure the tank is on. Open the lid of the BBQ. Turn one of the knobs until you hear a light hissing, then turn the knob further until it clicks and lights. If it doesn't light, just try again. Do the same for all other burners and side burner. To turn it off, simple turn the knob back to off. You do not need to turn the main propane tank off each time.



### Pots and Utensils

Your pots are in the cupboard next to the BBQ out side. Utensils can be found in the cabin.



### **Furnace**

In the cooler months your furnace will be on for you. You control the heat using the thermostat on the wall.





## The Deer Den Outhouse

Your cabin's washroom the outhouse next to the cabin. It has some essentials like toothpaste, wipes and hand sanitizer.

### Our Dogs

We do have dogs on the property, but we keep them at the main house when we have guests. They are always up for a play upon request.



### Trading Post

The Trading Post has lots of things for your pet. There are food bowls, bags and tie outs. Plus, the Bark Box outside the Trading Post has lots of toys to borrow while you're here.



### Dog Friendly Things To Do

Mikisew Provincial Park has a great dog beach where pups can run off leash and access the water. It's about 15 minutes from us, and we have a pass you can use so you don't have to pay. If we don't have other guests, your dogs are welcome to be off leash. Dogs love to run free in the back Annex.

# What To Expect

## Campfires

Don't worry if you've never lit a campfire. We can light it for you or teach you how.

You have firewood and kindling at your cabin. There are also fire starters inside.

Put down some kindling, light a fire starter and put it on top. Keep adding kindling until you have a good flame. Then add small pieces of wood. Always go from smaller to bigger.

## Power

Your cabin's lights and charging station are run by solar power. When you're not in the cabin, please keep the lights off. To charge your devices, simply turn on the switch on the inverter and charge away. Please do not plug in larger items like kettles / hair dryers. These will drain the system leaving you with no power.

Rarely, when the system runs out of power you will hear an alarm sound. Don't worry, just turn off the inverter.

## **Outdoor Shower**



The outdoor shower runs in the warmer months. It's solar powered and uses rainwater. You will have hot water in moments and we have towels in the Trading Post you can use. There is shampoo and body wash in the shower.

# The Trading Post

## Tuck Shop

The Tuck Shop is our little store. We have treats for you to enjoy while you're here and memorabilia to take home like hats and stickers.

# **Local Treasures**



#### Screaming Heads

Artist Peter Camani has created an immense artscape of huge cast-concrete sculptures throughout his 310-acre property. Visitors are welcome to wander the trails that wind through meadows, past woods and ponds, to get up close to his artwork. This is a must see. It's free (donations are accepted) and dog friendly.



### Aspen Valley Wildlife Sanctuary

This one is a personal favourite. You can book a tour and they will get you up close and personal with their permanent residents and will tell you all about the animals they are rehabilitatine to release back to the wild. NOT pet friendly.



#### The Antler Farm

An amazing local treasure. They offer guided Farm tours where you get to go into the pen to see their most impressive Deer. They have photography packages with the Deer and a Gallery featuring beautiful wildlife and nature!



#### Ontario Provincial Parks

A stay with us includes access to any Ontario Provincial Park. We are close to Mikisew and it has a great beach and dog area. Depending where you're coming from, we can book you a day pass to any park you'd like. Often people drive past Arrowhead or Algonquin. Just let us know, and we'll arrange the pass for you at no charge.

### **Our Trails**

Feel free to hike the property. We are working on hiking trails through the Annex. The field in the Annex is amazing for stargazing. There are snowshoes you can borrow in the Trading Post



### **Trans Canada Trail**

Walk out from the parking lot and turn right. This road will turn into an arm of the Trans Canada Trail. You can hike all across Canada if you'd like! The start of the trail is about a five minute walk down the road.



## **High Rock Lookout**

In Sundridge is a little park with an amazing view of Lake Bernard. In the fall it's amazing. The trail in the park is small, but the view is worth it.



## **Eagle Lake Narrows**

Eagle Lake Narrows has great beaches and fishing. The general store rents canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, motor boats and bicycles.
