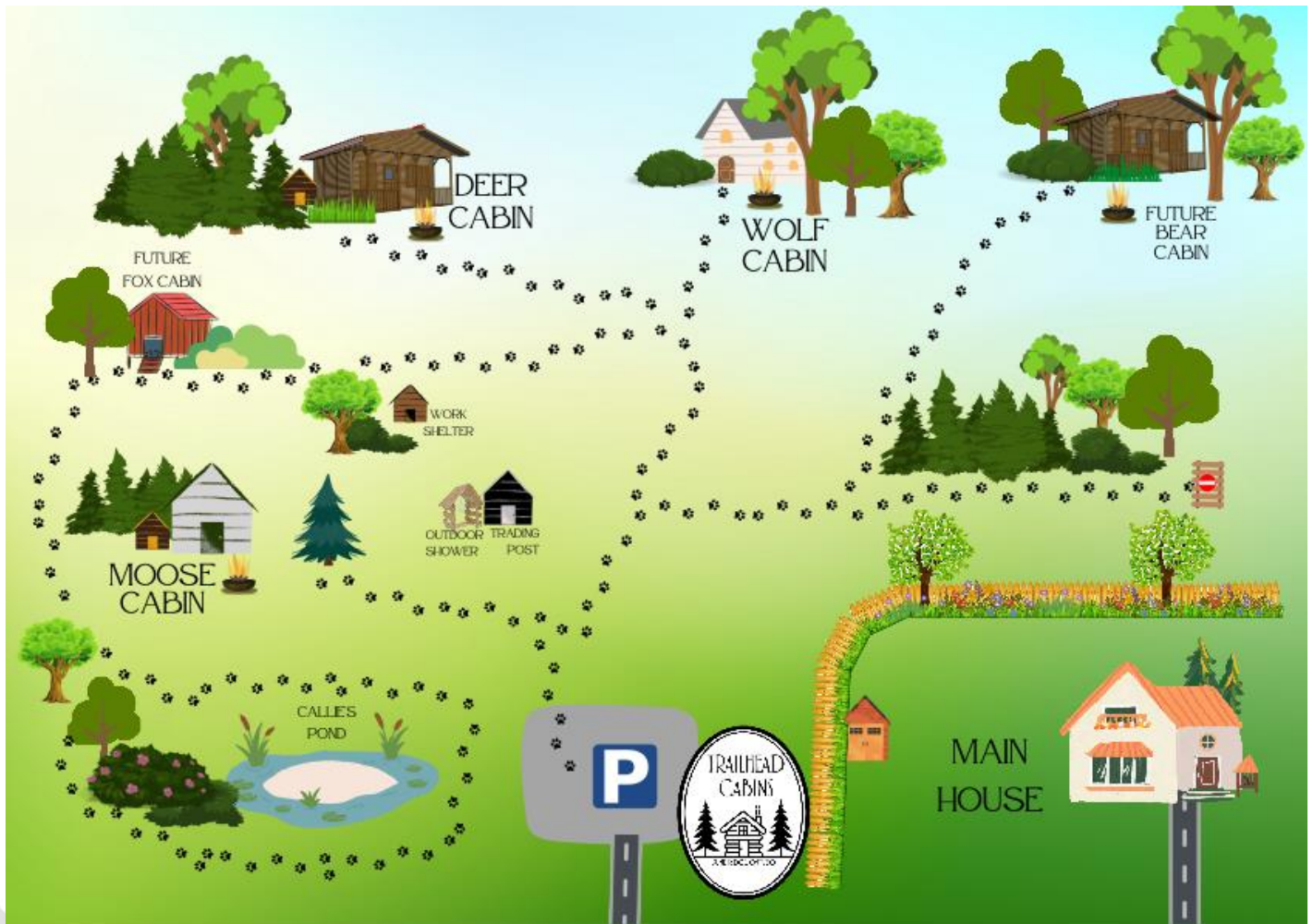

DOGS

Our dogs, Sherman, Simcoe and Callie, run on the property. We keep them on leashes when we have guests, but if they do get to you, they are very friendly with people and other dogs. If this poses a problem, please let us know.

GARBAGE

Feel free to leave your garbage in the can under the table. Your doggie poop and empties can stay outside. We'll take care of it after you go.





CAMP FIRES

If you need them, there are fire starters in your cabin. Next to your firepit there is kindling and firewood, and water to douse your fire at the end of your burning.

Please never leave the fire unattended and make sure it's completely out before bed.

POWER

Your cabin is powered by a solar panel. The power it produces is meant to allow you to charge your devices and provide light.

Your power comes from the inverter on the bottom shelf. Ensure that the power button is on, then plug in your device. Please do not plug in anything that draws significant power (like a kettle / toaster). This will drain the battery and will leave you unable to charge anything else.

Rarely, the system may set off a little humming alarm if it runs out of power. If this happens, the machine





HIKING TRAILS

ATVing

Food & Cooking

The BBQ is for you to do all your cooking. The pots and pans are in the wooden cabinet next to the BBQ. The side burner works great. The igniter on the BBQ works, but there are lighters in the cabin if you need. Please let me know if you happen to run out of propane. You should keep your food in the cabin at night just in case the critters find it. The water in the cabin is for cooking and drinking. Please let me know if you run out.

Smoking and Vaping

Please do not smoke or vape in the cabin. You're welcome to do that outside or on the screened porch. You can put your butts in the fireplace.

Out Houses

Your toilet is a simple system. Please do not put anything in the toilet besides toilet paper and waste. You can use the water to help your waste "flush". If you happen to run out of supplies in the bathroom let me know.



Out and About

Screaming Heads – Burk’s Falls

Burk’s Falls, about half an hour south, has a great exhibit / hiking trails called Screaming Heads. A local artist has created amazing (and huge) art throughout his property. You can wander through the trails and look at the art. Definitely worth a visit, and it’s



North Bay

North Bay is an hour north and has all the chain stores of any larger city. There are also a couple of museums and attractions.

High Rock Lookout

Crystal Cave and Artisan Village

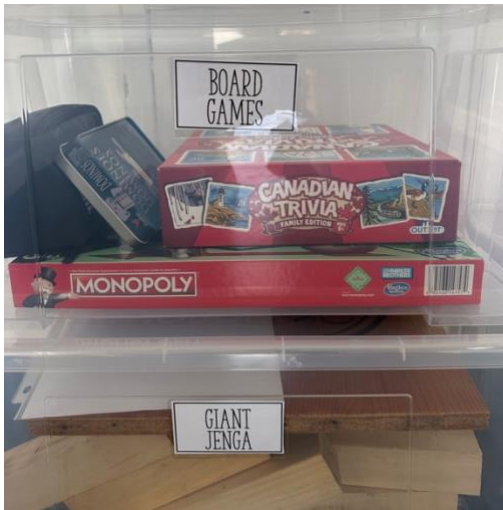
