2 DAYS / 1 NIGHT

DAY 1.

- Morning departure and pick-up from your hotel and/or airport.
- A brief description of our beautiful island and its main attractions, followed by transfer to the "Bellavista Nanay" tourist pier.
- We will stop at the confluence of the Amazon and Nanay Rivers to observe how the two rivers do not mix uniformly, creating a picture similar to "Café con Leche" (Coffee with Milk). We will begin the journey to our lodge, located a 1hour boat ride downstream, observing its different villages along the mighty Amazon River, considered one of the 7 natural wonders of the world, aboard comfortable and safe boats.
- You will see many species of birds that feed on the riverbanks. Continuing our
 journey, we will visit a Yaguá native group to learn about their customs, typical
 clothing, dialect, way of life, and culture. Demonstration with the blowgun
 (pucuna), a useful hunting instrument, which you have the privilege of using and
 participating in their traditional dances.
- Upon arrival at our Lodge, you will be assigned to your private cabins and toured for a typical self-service lunch.







- In the afternoon, tour the Amazon River and enjoy the beautiful landscapes. We will continue our journey to demonstrate our skills in artisanal piranha fishing, just like the locals do, with the possibility of seeing dolphins (gray and pink) in their natural habitat. Patience and attention are required to see them.
- Depending on the weather, you will have the opportunity to swim in the majestic Amazon River, where you can enjoy a picturesque sunset before returning to the Lodge.
- After dinner, we'll have a NIGHT WALK to listen to the magical sounds of the jungle and observe nature, insects, frogs, tarantulas, snakes, etc.
 DAY 2.
- Departure at 5:30 am, to walk through the town of Sinchicuy to observe the birds singing and watch the sunrise.
 Breakfast
- Excursion to the riverside community where we will visit the wildlife project, cataloged as an "ANIMAL RESCUE CENTER." We will observe many varieties of wild animals, such as sloths, monkeys, achunis, macaws, anacondas, and the prehistoric turtle (matamata), completely free of charge. We will then visit the mill, where exotic drinks are made from sugarcane liquor. We will also learn about the wide variety of natural medicines: sangre de grado (blood sugar) and copaiba resin.
- After our educational visit, we will head to the Lodge for a typical lunch made with local products. We offer vegetarian options and special diets; arrangements can be made with advance notice.
- Return to Iquitos and transfer to your hotel or airport. Our guide will coordinate
 with you at the most convenient time.
- Arrival in Iquitos at approximately 5:30 p.m.
