The AAEGV reserves the right to reject any art that does not meet our expectations or conforms to the norms of the community.

Sale & Display: All artwork must remain up for the duration of the Juried Art Show until released from the exhibit by the club. 20% commission will be charged on all sales. All commission proceeds will directly benefit art programming.
