## **Rules for Submission:**

- •One Entry may be submitted per member, with a \$10 hanging fee
- •Art in Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Pastel, Drawing Media, and Mixed Media may be submitted.
- •Dimensions: any size up to 30" wide, *including frame*
- •Works must be suitably framed with a taut wire for hanging. Ends of the wires must be taped to avoid injury.

A high resolution image must be sent to <u>aaegvexhibits@gmail.com</u> by December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 in order for promotional items to be designed and the poets need images in order to write an applicable poems. #### IMPORTANT INFORMATION
