## Breaking free of the reference

Oct. 27th 2021



Anne Kauff has been painting in oils for over 25 years. She has won awards for her plein air painting, shown in galleries, been selected for numerous artist residency programs, and her works hang in private collections across the country. Her exhibition at Reinvent Gallery was featured in the arts section of the Chicago Tribune as pick of the week. She is a passionate teacher and enjoys helping students find their own way of working.

Kauff believes that the artist's journey is a process of discovery - a movement from painting what we see (which is daunting enough), to being able to express what we are feeling. How do we use the tools in our tool box to convey our own ideas, rather than copying a photo or mimicking the work of other artists.

She works by finding inspiration, interpreting reference material, using color to elicit emotion, cropping, editing, and being willing to scrape down to the canvas when things aren't working. She will not be presenting a formula to follow, but sharing a way of working that encourages experimentation and pursuit of a vision that is uniquely yours.
