

## B) Trees Exhibition - March 1st - 29th, 2025

The **Trees Juried Exhibition** has been officially moved to the month of March from April as previously mentioned in the alert sent out to members a few weeks ago. If you missed the alert, there is still time to enter this year's **juried show**.

1) *Registration* deadline: Saturday, February 8, 2025. No entries will be accepted after the deadline. To register, email a copy of this completed form (attached to the newsletter) and a photo of your painting to Marie Bass @ mbass417@att.net by February 8th. Then, complete your registration at the Pavilion Front Desk – in person or by mail. This completed form must be submitted with payment by Saturday, Feb 8<sup>th</sup>.



- 2) Drop off your painting at the Elk Grove Library on Saturday, March  $1^{\rm st}$  between 9:15 10:30 am. Judging will take place after the drop-off and hanging of the art.
- 3) A light reception will take place at the library on Sunday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> from 3:00-4:30 pm.
- 4) Rules for Submission:
  - a) One piece of art may be submitted by either an AAEGV member or non-member.
  - b) AAEGV Member fee: \$15.00 / Non-member fee: \$20.00
  - c) Trees must be the <u>primary</u> subject matter.
  - d) Ms. Karen Sako will be our judge. Cash prizes will be awarded.
  - e) Art in Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Pastel, Drawing Media, and Mixed Media may be submitted.
  - f) All work must be for sale. Labels will be provided.
  - g) Dimensions including frame: no smaller than 8"x10" or larger than 24"x30". Work must be framed with a taut wire for hanging. Tape ends of the wires to avoid injury.
  - h) The AAEGV retains 10% from the sale of all paintings during this exhibition.
  - i) Work shown at previous Juried Exhibits will not be accepted.
  - j) All work must be original to the artist and may not be from a workshop, class, or kit. Complete this Entry form and submit it with your check, payable to the Elk Grove Park District and hand it in by Saturday afternoon, February 8<sup>th</sup>. (If mailing, allow for more time)
