- * If you're going to be doing any work with loud equipment, wait until after 9:00 am.



LANDSCAPING NOTES

During October, all lawns will be cut very low. This is done to remove thatch build up and enhance soil and turf health. But, when the lawns are cut low, they will look very bad for a week or so, but then will rebound very quickly. After the "low cut" is done, all lawns will be reseeded with perennial rye grass so the lawns will look healthy and green through the winter.



MONTHLY MAINTENANCE ROTATION DETAILS

Our landscape vendor provides additional maintenance on a six week rotation.

Weekly, they are to mow and edge the lawn.

But every 6 weeks, their scope of work includes:

*Trimming of shrubs, bushes, and trees

*Checking irrigation system

*Pulling any visible weeds

*Blowing any leaves
