

Let's Travel Detailed Itinerary

#### Day 01:

- ARRIVE IN AMRITSAR & TRANSFER TO HOTEL
- Welcome to Amritsar! Meet our representative from Holidays To Himachal, and transfer to your hotel. Check-in at the hotel, followed by dinner and an overnight stay.

#### Day 02:

- AMRITSAR LOCAL SIGHTSEEING
- This morning, after breakfast, enjoy a full day of local sightseeing in Amritsar. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.
- Places to Visit:
- Golden Temple: Also called Sri Harmandir Sahib or Swarna Mandir, this revered shrine was designed by Guru Arjan Sahib. Its foundation was laid by the Muslim saint Hazrat Mian Mir Ji of Lahore on 1st December 1588.
- Wagah Border: This is the road border between India and Pakistan. It is a popular tourist spot due to the famous Beating Retreat Ceremony held daily before sunset. Nearly 5,000 people gather each day to witness the event, conducted by the Indian Border Security Force and Pakistan Rangers.
- Jallianwala Bagh: A site of great historical significance related to India's freedom struggle. This public garden houses a national memorial established in 1951 to commemorate the massacre of peaceful celebrators by British forces on April 13, 1919.
- Durgiana Temple: Also known as Lakshmi Narayan Temple, it is a Hindu temple located about 1.6 km from the Golden Temple. The temple bears a striking resemblance to the Golden Temple and radiates peace and spirituality. It features a beautiful sarovar (pond) with idols of Goddess Lakshmi and Lord Vishnu.

### Day 03:

- AMRITSAR DHARAMSHALA & LOCAL SIGHTSEEING (200 KM / 4 HRS)
- After a delicious breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Dharamshala.
- In Hindu tradition, "Dharamshala" refers to a rest house for spiritual pilgrims. Historically, such shelters were built near pilgrimage sites to provide lodging for travelers.
- Sightseeing in Dharamshala:
- Dharamshala Cricket Stadium: Nestled in the lap of the majestic Himalayas, this stadium is situated at 1,457 meters above sea level, making it one of the highest sports grounds in the world. A visit here is a unique experience.
- McLeod Ganj: A suburb of Dharamshala, it is often referred to as "Little Lhasa" or "Dhasa" due to its large Tibetan population. It is a cultural and spiritual hub.
- Dalai Lama Temple (Tsuglakhang Temple): Located near the residence of the Dalai Lama, this temple complex features grand statues of Avalokiteshvara, Padmasambhava, and a large idol of Buddha. The chief prayer wheel is also a key attraction.
- Bhagsunath Temple: Located at 1,770 meters above sea level, this temple is surrounded by natural pools and lush greenery, attracting both tourists and devotees year-round.

### Day 04:

- DHARAMSHALA DALHOUSIE (120 KM / 4 HRS)
- After breakfast, drive to Dalhousie—often referred to as the "Mini Switzerland of India" for its breathtaking beauty. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore the local market. Overnight stay at the hotel.

#### Day 05:-

- DALHOUSIE KHAJJIAR (22 KM / 45 MINS) DALHOUSIE
- After a hearty breakfast, proceed for a day trip to Khajjiar.
- Khajjiar is an idyllic destination where you can spend the entire day admiring the beauty of the shimmering Khajjiar Lake, strolling across the 9-hole golf course, or simply soaking in the serenity. After an enjoyable visit, return to the hotel for an overnight stay.
- Places Covered:
- Chamera Lake View Point: Located in the Chamba district near Dalhousie, Chamera Lake (also known as Chamba Lake) is a man-made reservoir formed by the Chamba Dam. It is a popular destination for picnics and water activities like boating, kayaking, and canoeing.
- St. Francis Church: A prominent monument in Dalhousie, this church is located in the Moti Tiba area near Subhash Chowk. Built in 1894 by civil officers during the Victorian era, it features Belgian glass interiors and detailed stonework. Surrounded by deodar trees, it showcases 100-year-old carvings and dioramas.


