Article IV – Officers and Elections

Section 1. Purpose

The Executive Board is a representative group of the PTO and shall consist of eight (8) Officers. Collectively, the Executive Board of Officers is elected to transact necessary business in the intervals between general membership meetings. The Executive Board members are team members. The individual Board members are not intended to function independently nor in a state of isolation from one another. Board members shall communicate directly with the collective group and collaborate on common projects. The Executive Board, by majority vote of all officers, may approve unbudgeted expenditures.

Section 2. Executive Board - Officers and Advisors

- I. The Executive Officers shall consist of two (2) Presidents, namely, Co-President A and Co-President B, four (4) Vice Presidents, namely, Vice President-Operations, Vice President-Community Engagement, Vice President-Communications, Vice President-Finance, Secretary, and Treasurer.
- II. The Advisors shall be two (2) Staff Representatives without voting rights.
- III. The outgoing Co-Presidents shall be invited to serve as advisors to the Executive Board for one year to ensure continuity.
