

Know Before You Go!

Hey, Tiger Parents/ Guardians! CMITSES Field Day is quickly approaching. Please see the information below to help you better understand how Field Day works!

What is CMITSES Field Day?

Field Day is a full school day, outdoor event that promotes cooperation, team building, school spirit, friendly competition and encourages sportsmanship through exciting activities and games.

Where is Field Day?

Field Day will be held on Friday, May 31, 2024, 9 AM – 1:30 PM, at Liberty Sports Parks – located at 220 Prince Georges Blvd, Upper Marlboro, MD 20774.

How can my student participate in Field Day?

Field Day is 100% FREE! For a student to participate in Field Day, they <u>must</u> return a signed permission slip to their homeroom teacher by Friday, May 24, 2024. If your scholar does not have a permission slip, please contact their teacher. Students that do not have a signed permission slip will remain at the school on Field Day.

Do I need to take my child(ren) to the Field Day Site?

<u>ALL</u> students will be transported to Liberty Sports Park via a bus provided by CMITSES. It is critical that students <u>arrive at school on time</u> to ensure that they can make the bus and be transported to the Field Day location. No parent/ guardian will be allowed to drop-off their student(s) at Liberty Sports Park on Field Day.

Should I pack lunch for my student?

Pizza (cheese and pepperoni) will be provided to students. If you would like your student(s) to have school lunch instead, please contact your child(ren)'s homeroom teacher or send a bagged lunch from home like other field trips.

Can I attend Field Day with my student?

Parents are unable to attend/observe field day. If you would like to volunteer, you must satisfy all PGCPS volunteer requirements and sign up via the PTO website.

Does my student need to wear their school uniform to Field Day?

All students are required to wear their appropriate class-color shirt, comfortable bottoms, and sneakers. Class color assignments are as follows:

Kindergarten | Yellow First Grade | Red Second Grade | Orange Third Grade | Purple Fourth Grade | Blue Fifth Grade | Green

I did not purchase a class shirt through the PTO, what is my student supposed to wear?

Parents/ guardians that did not purchase a shirt for their student(s) should provide a loose-fitting shirt in the appropriate grade-level color for their child(ren).

Can I pick up my child(ren) from Liberty Sports Park?

<u>ALL</u> students will be transported back to CMITSES for dismissal at 2:25 PM. No students will be dismissed from Field Day, no exceptions.

I am a chaperone for my student's class. Can I still sign up to volunteer?

If your student's teacher has confirmed your participation as a classroom chaperone, you are ineligible to participate as a volunteer. All parent/ guardian chaperones are required to stay with their assigned class group for the duration of Field Day. Your reporting location is also CMITSES so that you can ride the bus to and from the park with your assigned class as a chaperone. If you are unsure as to whether you are signed up as a chaperone, please contact your child(ren)'s teacher.

My child has medication on file in the nurse's office, will they still receive it May 31st?

All students with approved medication forms on file will still have access to their medicine on Friday, May 31st like all other school field trips. There will also be a first aid station at Field Day should any scholar need medical attention.

Will my scholar need a change of clothes, backpack, and water bottle?

Students should not bring any of these items to the Field Day event. Water and other hydration options will be available to students during field day.

Will there be a Zoom link or photos for parents/ guardians to view Field Day?

Field Day will not be livestreamed; however, photos will be shared via Class Dojo.
