




What We Can Control

- Signage has been posted on floors and in classrooms for social distancing and mask wearing
- Hand sanitizers are in every classroom and throughout the building
- Ordered individual clear desk sneeze guards for students
- Plexiglass clear dividers for front office, nurse, cafeteria and teachers desks
- Monitors for teachers for dual screen set up in the classroom
- Digital camera for teachers
- Emergency stock of N95 masks and gloves
- Cases of bottled water donated by Parent Liaison Mr. Upson, Administration and CLF
- Hired additional day and evening cleaning crew
- Updating HVAC with ionization hardware thanks to CLF

What will instruction look like?

- Students will be dropped off and temperature taken before entering the building via cafeteria entrance. (Any staff or students with a fever of 100.4 must be sent home per current covid protocols).
- Students if eating school meals would pick up breakfast and lunch and take it to classroom.
- No more than 12 students in a class 6 feet apart and every other row.
- Students would remain in same class the entire day.
- Students would participate in distance learning whether in the building or at home via their issued or personal device.
- Teachers would teach virtually from their classroom.
- CARTS and Services (ELL, SPED, TAG, Counseling Speech etc.) would also teach or conduct breakout rooms virtually from their classroom or office.
- Students would be dismissed exiting from Gym
