

- Ending Balance: \$27,175.77


501(c) (3) Status





Water Testing

To Parents and Guardians:

I am writing this letter to bring to the attention of our school community that we recently had our water tested and there were elevated levels of lead. We are currently having all water re-tested in our building. Due to Covid-19 restrictions all water fountains have been closed all year and all staff and all students have been provided bottled water each day since their return on March 17th and April 8th respectively. Thanks to our outstanding PTO and CLF we have more than enough bottled water for our Tiger family until the end of the school year.

Moving forward we await the results of the current water testing. The lack of drinkable water from plumbing does not affect our daily operation at any level. Additionally, a case of bottled water has been placed in each classroom and no water is being utilized for consumption on campus. I look forward to providing you more information as it becomes available to administration.
