

CAMP EXPECTATIONS

Please be familiar with the following before coming to camp!!!

- ❖ **A Completed, Signed Medical Forms MUST accompany campers on the bus!!!** Please have them ready to give to the adult on the bus when you board. All medication must be in its original containers and marked clearly with instructions. Or, you may put medications in a pill box clearly marked with name and when medication is taken (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, Bedtime, or as needed). Please place these in a plastic Ziploc bag and turn them over to the adult on the bus with the medical form. Medications will be turned over to the camp Medical Staff/ Director and dispensed as directed.
- ❖ Absolutely NO knives of any kind. If knives are needed, the staff will supply one.
- ❖ No electronics please. Camp WoTeKi is not responsible for lost/stolen items. There is no cell service or internet service at camp.
- ❖ Personal cleanliness is encouraged at all times - make sure your child has the appropriate amount of changes of underclothing, socks, etc.
- ❖ We will have Mail Call on Wednesday. We encourage all parents to write their child a letter for this time. You may turn your letters over to the adult at the transportation pick-up/ drop off locations when your child boards. Or, you may mail them by Tuesday to:

- ❖ You will need to provide any stamps needed for mail being sent from camp, which will be mailed when we have the opportunity. Please realize that letters to home may be received after the children return home.
- ❖ Meal time is for eating. We do not mind talking and encourage interaction at all times, but let's remember that at meal times the entire camp will be in the lodge at the same time so we need to keep the volume under control. Everyone must be quiet during announcements.
- ❖ Campers and their counselors will be responsible for a variety of chores throughout the week. These include litter pickup, KP, cleaning the shower house, sweeping, etc. They usually do not take a long time if everyone helps out.
- ❖ Discipline is handled on an individual basis; however, our general discipline policy is as follows:
 - ❖ 1st offense - warning
 - ❖ 2nd offense - time out from group
 - ❖ 3rd offense - conference with one of the directors
 - ❖ 4th offense - parents will be contacted
- ❖ Everyone will follow curfew times and stay in their cabins after lights out!
