## AFFIDAVIT IN RESPONSE

19AV-FA-22-3264

Because there are no specific allegations that show risk to the safety of my children, I am requesting that the Ex Parte Order be dismissed and that the Parenting Time Agreement that was ordered in October 2022, approved by the court, and recently reviewed by another judge, be immediately reinstated. I have never been physically or emotionally abusive with my children, and in fact, I am actually very protective. During the time that the Parenting Time Agreement (and before the agreement was in place when our children were shared between households), I have never violated its terms or agreements. Pursuant to Minnesota Law in cases where one parent deprives the other parent of court-ordered parenting time, the court can award compensatory parenting time and damages to the deprived parent, in this case that would be me, and further, this could include granting me sole custody and dismissing these frivolous claims. Specifically:

1. In response to Finding Number 4, Kirsten claims that I withheld the children from her parenting time. This is untrue. According to the Parenting time agreement currently in place, signed by Judge Amy Purzel on October 12, 2022 and reviewed by another judge on June 14, 2023, every Monday morning is included in my parenting time. She came to my house accompanied by an Apple Valley Police Officer at 7:30am demanding that I send out Miller, clearly a violation of my parenting time. Kirsten was confronted by Judge David Knutson at our June 14, 2023, pre-trial for intentionally and repeatedly violating our Parenting Time Agreement. Her motivation for filing this order is an abandoned and malignant heart. She took Miller to Bible camp and didn't want to produce Miller for my parenting day on Wednesday, June 28, 2023. Further, she was

planning on taking the children to her family's cabin for the July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday and would again be in violation of the parenting time order which states that the children are with me every Sunday at 9am through Monday. That is why she is making another set of false claims. I have agreed to the Parenting Time Agreement in place ever since she moved out while pregnant. Kirsten has violated the Parenting Time Agreement on the following dates: October 23, 24, 27, 30, 2022; November 6, 7, 10, 14, 20, 21 2022; December 4, 5, 8, 12, 19, 23, 2023; February 5, 6, 9, 13, 20, 23, 26, 27, 2023; March 2, 6, 12, 13, 16, 20, 23, 2023; April 13, 17, 23, 24, 27, 2023; May 1, 7, 8, 11, 15, 21, 22, 25, 2023; and June 4, 5, 8, 12, 2023. In fact, on June 14, 2023, Judge David Knuston reprimanded her for violating my court ordered Parenting Time Agreement.

2. Kirsten created a false narrative regarding the general supervision of the children. She cites a trip to Dave and Buster's Arcade claiming lack of supervision when, in fact, just the opposite is true. My father, sister, and brother-in-law (credit card evidence is available upon request) were all present and shared in the supervision. Line of Reach supervision existed for Collette and Quinn and Line of Site Supervision existed for Madison and Miller (my sister held Quinn for over 50% of that evening). She claims a lack of supervision when the children are outside. Again, absolutely untrue. I am with the children the entire time. She commented that Quinn was sitting in the street. But Kirsten's video evidence proves that I was a few feet from Quinn. And we live in a corner cul-de-sac with minimal traffic. Every child in our neighborhood can be seen playing kickball, riding scooters, bikes, and skateboards, playing street hockey, football, chalk art and a number of other activities. I am always outside with my girls watching them. She made comments about the children jumping off mattresses and being

muddy. The mattresses were awaiting recycling pick-up and the girls tipped them over and made a jumping game out of them like kids do. A fun activity that I closely supervised and video-recorded like almost all good parents do. This is something that would never cause any reasonable person any concern. And, yes, the girls were very muddy because we all were playing and jumping in the mud, like kids do. The fact that she would even include this in an attempt to create a false narrative of “lack of supervision”. It is embarrassing and grounds for contempt and perjury. Kirsten has a history of mental health crisis, specifically mental breakdowns about having to watch her kids alone and delusions about control. Kirsten has been seeing a counselor for depression our entire relationship and has suffered from post-partem syndrome. This could be why she suffers from delusions which have allowed her to lie on court documents with out any professional verifying her claims. Kirsten has not been able to live alone with the girls at any point. This is not because of finances, but because her inability to be a single parent or even a co-parent. She has made a mockery of this court and the justice it supposedly stands for.

3. Kirsten has created a false narrative regarding my mental health by stating that I am “getting worse” and becoming “more delusional.” Again, completely untrue. She has no data to support her claim. In December and January, I went through extensive in-patient and outpatient treatment for mental health. I had thorough testing including brain scans and tests. The question about concussions was addressed via MRI and examination by Neurologist Dr. Vladimir Savcenko on December 31, 2022 at Regions Hospital St. Paul (see attached report from Dr. Savcenko). Moreover, I am prescribed cannabis, Adderall, Amlodipine, Divalproex, Melatonin, Risperidone. Which is all legally prescribed

medication for ADHD and Bipolar. The 12-Panel Follicle Test is not necessary because I stipulate the use of the medications as previously stated. Please see attached blood analysis. In addition, after consulting with a free legal professional, it is my understanding “in cases of divorce and when ordered to do so, it is the responsibility of the requesting party to pay for this procedure.” Since the procedure can cost \$400 and I am unemployed without any source of income (insurance does not pay for this, and my social worker will not provide transportation for this procedure because it is not considered medically necessary), this is an impossible task. I go in public places all the time without any concerns; thus, refuting with evidence, her assertion that my situation is getting worse.

4. Kirsten also claims that my judgement is poor when it comes to the children. This is untrue. She sites sunburn faces on a trip to Florida claiming that I failed to apply sunscreen. My sister will testify that she applied sunscreen to my children on several occasions throughout the day. In addition, we kept the children in shaded areas as much as possible and even moved some of our activities to the evening. Again, very surprising that she would make *sunburn* a matter for a judge to consider. This is particularly puzzling when the children come from her parents’ house with huge welts and bug bites because she believes bug spray will kill you as she does not believe in applying repellants. Kirsten has also left our children in the trunk of a hot car unattended, which should be more worrisome. Kirsten also has guns in her home at 10225 Brent Ave. The court needs to address her poor judgment by putting our children in danger or harm. Moreover, she refuses to use fever reducing medication despite the severity of the child’s fever. She even refuses to have the children vaccinated for any of the 26 scheduled

vaccinations. In terms of reasonableness for our childrens safety and health, the greater concern may be with her being around our children until she seeks a mental health evaluation.

5. Kirsten has also created a false narrative regarding the poor condition of my home and cites lack of a working refrigerator. In fact, I have two functioning refrigerators which are fully stocked including organic fruit, vegetables, and meat. The cupboards are filled with canned and other goods and my children are provided meals from Chipotle, Chic-a filet, Texas Roadhouse, Culvers, Starbucks, Caribou, and so forth. My home is freshly painted and has four bedrooms with beds, desks, and dressers, four bathrooms, a huge family room, living room, kitchen and includes a rather large yard. There are thousands of dollars in age-appropriate toys, hundreds of books, and many clothes. Again, I am uncertain why Kirsten would bring a “lack of refrigerator” concern to the courts when she knows full-well that the home does indeed have two functioning refrigerator.
6. The false claims Kirsten is making are frivolous and a waste of the courts time and money. I ask the court to consider Kirsten seek mental health treatment and counseling for her delusions.
7. Please see my Affidavit for Candidacy of President of the United States of America. I do not understand what point Ms. Wagner and Ms. Conboy are trying to make by attacking my presidential campaign. I already have endorsements, political donations, and a campaign website at [andrewconboyforpresident.com](http://andrewconboyforpresident.com). I volunteer for the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children who help the over 800,000 trafficked children in America and it is a pillar of my presidential campaign. I find it disrespectful that Ms. Wagner referred to me as a Q’Anon conspiracy theorists for my volunteer work and

raising awareness trafficked children around America. Disparaging comments like this are grounds for compensatory damages since Ms. Wagner has no proof of that statement being true while making it under oath with penalty of perjury in the public court of record.

8. All my videos on social media are protected under the First Amendment and the express right to freedom of speech.
9. I have never been a danger to Kirsten Conboy who has not been living with me since 2019. She lied about the dates and incidents on her initial OFP. I have never been a danger to my children, the exact opposite, I am the most protective father on the planet and I care for their safety more than anything. Those four girls changed my life for the better. They taught me how to love unconditionally.
10. Kirsten has been abusive physically and verbally and has made threats of bodily harm and violence towards me. She attacked me with a hammer in our basement in 2019 before she finally moved out. She damaged the basement door and doorknob with the hammer, and I ran out of the house. She has smashed multiple phones, TVs and dishware throughout my home. She threw away my XBOX video game set in 2019. She has hit me in my genitalia and slapped me on many occasions. On July 26, 2022 Kirsten sent me a video of her shooting guns stating she was using my head as target practice. She then deleted this message off my daughter's iPad. The comment that has had the most effect on my mental health is when she told me my mom was fat and would die soon. And then about three months later, my mom Kathy Conboy, flew to heaven on March 17, 2021. She made repeated disparaging comments to me about my mom after her death, such as my mom gave me herpes and cold sores and made these comments in front of our

children. Another comment that has had a major impact on our children is when she stated to my oldest daughter that I was crazy and delusional. We were ordered by Judge Amy Purzel to not make disparaging comments about each other. My mental health is a disability under the ADA and has special protections under the law. Why is Kirsten heard laughing in her audio transcript when she was in contempt of the parenting time court order.

11. Kirsten constantly would fight with my entire family over many social and political issues. She would site conspiracy theories such as vaccines have aborted babies in them and that is why she did not give them to her kids. Another conspiracy theory Kirsten fought with my family over is the government is trying to kill us through the food supply. She would make fun of my family for not buying organic food. Whenever my mom would send home food, Kirsten would throw it in the garbage. Another conspiracy she talked about was how kid's clothes have chemicals in them that can kill children. She would throw away any clothes my mom or myself bought that she thought had chemicals. She said the clothes would kill our children and give them cancer if she didn't throw them away.

12. One afternoon in June 2019 I came home from work to find the children all by themselves and Kirsten was hiding in a closet covered in clothes having a panic attack. I asked her what was wrong and why are the kids outside alone. She said she was having a panic attack and that she could not handle being a mom. This is why Kirsten must live with her parents Steve and Deb Czeck. It is because she truly cannot live alone with our children. She has never lived alone in her entire life. She has never lived alone while having kids. She abandoned me and my daughters on many occasions and left me alone

with them. I have raised these girls as a single dad on my own since 2019. Kirsten has proven she cannot parent on her own or co parent.

13. Kirsten stocked me outside my home for over an hour banging on the door on April 6, 2022. She left the four girls at home with her mom Deb. I did not want a confrontation with Kirsten, and I did not answer the door. She called the Apple Valley police and told them that I did not give her money to watch the girls and that she needed a pair of the girl's shoes. I let the police officer in and gave him a pair of shoes and even though there is no financial agreement, I gave Kirsten \$200 cash in front of the Apple Valley police officer. This same evening Kirsten stated I needed to write her a check for \$10,000 to watch the kids or they would have to stay with me. She has this delusion that I have a ton of money and owe it all to her. All these statements can be corroborated by the attached Police Report #AV22001895.
14. Kirsten got the police called on her for not watching our girls and for them not wearing shoes on November 6, 2022. She was at my residence just 25 days after she perjured the courts, falsely claiming she feared me and that I was a danger to her. I asked Kirsten why she was at my house when she should not be. I asked Kirsten why did she show up at my house unannounced just 25 days after she said I was a danger to her and she was fearful of me? I had no contact with Kirsten at this point and she just showed up out of nowhere with our girls. This proves she lied and perjured the court to obtain a void ab initio OFP from Judge Amy Purzel on October 12, 2022. Someone reported the girls to the police for not wearing shoes outside. Please see attached Apple Valley police report #AV22006920 where Kirsten had the audacity to blame my mental health. Instead of blaming herself for the disregard of her own OFP. Plus, she let the girls play outside with no shoes in 55

degree weather, when a neighbor called the police on her because there concern for welfare of the children. I was inside cleaning the basement when all this happened. In the police report dated November 6, 2022 it states my address of 15174 Dupont Path and is dated after the OFP was ordered on October 12, 2022. You will see Kirsten's false statements blaming my mental health. First, if she was so worried about my mental health why wasn't she watching the girls? Second, she should not have been at my house no matter what. This was her parenting time day and she decided to show up to my residence 25 days after an OFP order and get the police called on her. Lastly, she had the audacity to lie to the police officer and continue to blame my mental health for her inability to just simply watch our girls.

15. Kirsten has refused to use the MyFamily Wizard app that was ordered by Judge Amy Purzel on October 12, 2022 for communication between us. She stated that it was too much to pay for. She has been paying for lip injections, plastic surgery, cosmetic eyebrows, a gym membership, daycare, a cell phone bill, and car insurance. She pays no rent or mortgage because she has been living with her parents at 10255 Brent Ave, Inver Grove Heights, MN 55077 since 2019. I purchased Miller Conboy, our oldest daughter, two separate cell phones that I told Kirsten were to stay with the Miller so we could communicate with the girls if she was not going to download the My Family Wizard app. These two phones have since disappeared and the girls were never allowed to use them. One phone was a ORBIT SPECTRUM flip-phone and the other was a black Nokia prepaid smartphone that are still missing. She has always had a way to communicate with our children, but has refused to be amicable.

16. This most recent Apple Valley police report where Kirsten showed up to my residence with no communication in advance and falsely claiming it was her parenting time on Monday June 26, 2023 needs to be addressed. First, my father Tim Conboy is the one who transports the girls. Kirsten specifically requested that she do not come pick up the girls at my residence. She even made the Apple Valley police aware of this in one of her reports to them. Why did she show up at 7:30 am pounding on the door? My dad arranged to drop the girls off later in the afternoon like he and Kirsten agreed on earlier. My dad can testify to this. Second, Kirsten was taking pictures of me through my window after I woke up and while I did not have any clothes on. This is an act of gross negligence and malpractice by Mack Santana Law Firm; the fact they allowed that picture to be submitted to the court as evidence is a serious invasion of my privacy. I cannot believe her attorney Ms. Laurie Mack-Wagner would allow this to be submitted as evidence that her client illegally photographed me through my window without any clothes on. That is an invasion of my privacy and violation of my constitutional protections against invasion of privacy. The court clerk or judge who allowed this picture to be submitted also invaded my privacy.


17. Kirsten cites my behavior as a professional hockey player, claiming that I had a propensity for violence. A claim that is untrue. Physical players are part of the game and league rules and policies specify consequences for players as such. The leagues and teams in which I played obviously recognized and supported my style as I was offered dozens of scholarships and drafted into the NHL. She is using "hockey fighting imagery" to form a nexus between my on-ice behavior as a professional hockey player and the way I conduct myself as a parent and community member. Clearly, no such nexus exists. Since retiring from professional hockey, I have coached high school hockey, high school football, high school track and field, youth

hockey, youth soccer, and youth track and field. All these coaching opportunities required vetting and rigorous background checks. There were never any concerns with any of my employers who I coached youth sports for. And there were never any concerns from my teammates about me being violent. Again, Ms. Mack-Wagner and Ms. Conboy are acting with gross negligence with making false claims that defame my character and good standing in the community.

In summary, I have refuted Kirsten's statements which supported the Ex Parte Order and request that the Ex Parte Order be dismissed and I be awarded sole custody of the children. I pray the court hold Kirsten and her representation accountable for making false claims that have resulted in serious violations of my Constitutional guarantee to equal due process.

I'm writing a statement regarding the safety of my nieces, Andrew Conboy's children, while he is providing for their care. This is in response to a recently filed Order for Protection.

I have observed Andrew on hundreds of occasions during his parenting time, including in his home as well as in other settings including waterparks, parks, zoos, and on vacations to Florida. I have observed him being attentive, responsible, and protective. I believe the children are safe and well taken care of under his care. Andrew loves his children more than anything and they are his top priority. Unlike other parents, he is fully engaged with his kids.

I am aware of two specific claims that were stated by his wife, Kirsten. She made a claim that sunscreen was not applied to the children on our most recent trip to Florida. This claim is false. RE: Wednesday, June 28, 2023 and Monday, June 26, 2023

Kirsten and I had phone conversations on June 28, 2023, for the purpose of discussing the time in which I would pick-up the children for Drew's parenting day. To mesh with my work schedule, we agreed on 11am. Kirsten stated that her attorney advised her that the children should not be picked-up until the "afterschool time" so that there was compliance with the Parenting Time Agreement. I challenged her attorney's advice, citing compliance with the Parenting Time Agreement, with a question regarding whether Miller would then be at her home so that she would be able to see her father pursuant to the agreement. In the second conversation, Kirsten stated that I could pick-up the girls at 2:40pm; I protested slightly because of meeting adjustments that I rescheduled for that time, and she offered to drop them off. However, I told her I would flex my schedule and pick-up the girls at 2:40pm. I did ask her if she was going to pick-up Miller from camp, and she stated she would not be doing that. I arrived at her home at 2:40pm. Kirsten asked me if I read her text, but I had not yet done so. Kirsten stated that she was unwilling to allow the girls to go to Andrew's home because she was concerned for their safety. She added that she and Andrew would take the matter up with the courts. I explained this to Andrew over the phone.

At 7:30pm, I received a phone call from Andrew where he stated that Kirsten and her attorney filed an Ex Parte Order for Protection (naming the children) and that he sent the order to my email.
