Andrew threw food including smashing a cantaloupe, a bag of apples, and a plate of food, all over the floor in a rage in front of Quinn and Colette almost hitting Quinn with food. He raided the cupboards and started throwing away food in the garbage because he was upset i threw away old stale popcorn he "paid \$20 for". At this point, throwing food and my things on floor and in the garbage became a daily practice to try to intimidate me to leave the home. This incident was very concerning to me and the fact he almost hit Quinn with the food potentially injuring her. There is picture and voice recording to substantiate this incident.

He has had many concussions from playing hockey and he has made comments to me in the past about "blacking out" during hockey fights because of his anger. He is increasingly threatening, proved by our most recent car incident on 9/1/22 and 9/8/22 attempting to leave with the children. His increasingly paranoid and delusional thoughts have him convinced that not only "people" are following him, but now he has accused me of orchestrating this delusion. I have great fear of what could happen should i not receive this order.

I would like to extend the option to Facetime and speak to the kids over phone calls as long as he is respectful. Once a phycological and drug evaluation are completed and it is deemed safe for the children to be around him, I would ask that supervised visitation be integrated. His dad can supervise the visits, but i ask that Andrew not drive the kids due to drug use, history of not buckling them and is a flight risk to leaving with them.

Andrew has been experiencing extreme delusions and paranoia recently. He also has a very long substance abuse history, and has been physically, and verbally abusive to me with our children present in the past. He has also has a history of mental health issues, most pressing was a suicidal ideation/attempt in September 2020. These can be substantiated by police report/calls, pictures, video and voice recordings upon request, spanning the past 2 years. I was not aware of this situation until yesterday in regards to the delusions and paranoia. He and I had an hour and a half long conversation last night, where he detailed the many instances of paranoia he has experienced recently. In this conversation he explains "people are following him" including to the gym. He recently confronted a man at the gym for "filming" him and my youngest daughter Quinn at the pool, with Quinn present during the confrontation. He has set up a "decoy" of Halloween inflatables along the road behind his house "so people will look that way" and his camera he hid in the trees can see their faces. He also has a chair facing the road he has been sitting on watching cars pass by as early as "6 am". He insists the same cars drive back and forth multiple times and "give signals" some of the "signals" these people give are using the visor of their car, talking into the cuff of their shirts, always on their cell phones, sometimes "they smoke cigarettes" and he also claimed one man made a "signal" by opening a newspaper while driving. He has said at least 12 people are involved in this operation of surveillance. He showed me a digital camera roll he has of "suspicious people". He has had suspicions of multiple people at the gym that have had ear buds in and have been on zoom calls. He said he has confronted these people and have asked them why they are on zoom calls at the gym. He claimed one man walked up to him at the gym and asked if he was Andrew Conboy. I asked him what he said and he said he put a towel over his head and walked away without answering the man and left as soon as possible. When asking him why would such an orchestrated group of people be following him, he accused me of having him followed. I assured him this was not the case. He then thought maybe a bank was trying to serve him. He told me he has called every private investigators office in Dakota County and told them to "stop following him" or he would "call the attorney general's office" on them. He also asked me to take the girls for the weekend which i happily agreed, as i would like him seen for a mental and drug evaluation. He then told me he planned to "head south" i asked him what that meant and he didn't elaborate other than saying going down 35. He told me he has had conversations with his dad, his sister and even the police about people following him and everyone has told him "he's insane" and "should get help". Another concern of mine is he has been talking about this in front of the children and i asked him to stop because i do not want him to scare them, and make them think someone is following them. He even had his young niece keep an eye on a car down the road. He has switched cars with his dad and his sister as to try to "loose them" Upon letting him know me and the girls would be leaving to return home, he asked me a for a favor to "prove" he was being followed. He asked me to drive him to his dad's house a couple minutes down the road. At first i declined, citing lack of room in the car, but after him insisting, I agreed to drive him to his dad's house with our older daughter Miller sitting on his lap. I told him i wanted to go through the neighborhood roads and not on a main road. Once in the drive way and in the car, before he got in, a car drove down the street past us. He starred at the car and pointed at the car for a long time. He told me "that was one of them". Once in the car, with our daughter on his lap, we proceeded to drive. Shortly into the drive he made a switch in plans and requested i not drop him off at his dad's but instead on the side of the road, at a park or at Lebanon Hills. I told him absolutely not and his options were to be dropped back off at home or to his dad's house like i agreed. He came increasingly aggressive and agitated with me, starting to yell. I quickly became afraid,

as i was driving and thought he may try to take hold of the wheel or something to that effect. He then demanded i take him to my house. I again said no, and continued to drive to his dad's house. Once i turned to the next street, he completely lost it and was screaming at me and slamming his hand on the dash board. My daughter Miller who was sitting in his lap began to burst into tears and was sobbing. His outburst was extremely scary to me and to my children. I asked him to stop because he was scaring me and her. I tried to stay calm and just wanted to get him out of the car as safely and as fast as possible. Once we pulled into the drive way he continued be-raiding me and specifically speaking to the children saying "your mom won't even give me a ride" among other things. He then went inside the house and slammed the door. I contacted his dad and we spoke about the situation. And both agreed the best thing is for him to have a phycological evaluation. His dad mentioned trying to get him to agree to be checked out at Riverside. I am requesting an order of protection for myself and my children based on the ongoing circumstances of paranoia and delusions, coupled with the long history of his substance, physical, verbal abuse and also previous mental health issues. He also has a documented history of not buckling their car seats or even seatbelts. This is extra concerning because of the paranoia we experienced in the car, and his comment about "going south on 35".

1. The Petition alleges an immediate danger of domestic abuse.
2. The following parties need an Order for Protection and are referred to in this Order as "Protected Person(s)":

3. A hearing is required to address the relief requested in the Petition.

Based upon these findings, IT IS ORDERED:

1. A hearing will be held at Dakota County Govt Center, 1560 Highway 55, Hastings, MN 55033 on September 16, 2022 @ 9:00 am. The requested relief is temporarily granted as set out below. At the scheduled hearing, the Court will decide whether this Order for Protection will remain in effect, and whether any other relief will be granted. IF RESPONDENT FAILS TO APPEAR FOR THE HEARING, THE ORDER MAY REMAIN IN EFFECT OR A NEW ORDER MAY BE ISSUED. IF RESPONDENT FAILS TO APPEAR AT THE HEARING, THE RESPONDENT MUST STILL OBEY THIS ORDER OR ANY OTHER ORDER FOR PROTECTION ISSUED BY THE COURT IN THIS CASE. IF PETITIONER FAILS TO APPEAR FOR THE HEARING,

THIS CASE MAY BE DISMISSED.

2. Respondent shall appear personally and respond to the petition. IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR YOU MAY BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT.
3. Respondent must not commit acts of domestic abuse against the Protected Person(s). This means that Respondent may not harm or cause fear of harm to the Protected Person(s), and that Respondent may not use, attempt to use, or threaten to use physical force that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury to the Protected Person(s).
4. Respondent must not have any contact with the Protected Person(s) whether in person, with or through other persons, by telephone, mail, e-mail, through electronic devices, social media, or by any other means except as follows: no exceptions
5. Respondent must not go to or enter the residence(s) of the Protected Person(s) located at the address(es) listed below. Respondent must stay a reasonable distance away from the residence(s) of the Protected Person(s) specifically as follows: 4 blocks and Respondent must stay a reasonable distance away from ANY FUTURE RESIDENCES of the Protected Person(s). NOTICE: RESPONDENT MUST NOT ENTER OR STAY AT THE RESIDENCE OF THE PROTECTED PERSON(S) FOR ANY REASON, EVEN IF INVITED TO DO SO. IF RESPONDENT IS FOUND AT THE PROTECTED PERSON'S RESIDENCE, THE PROTECTED PERSON IS NOT IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER, AND THE ORDER REMAINS IN EFFECT.

6. Respondent must not call or enter the following place:

7. Neither party shall sell, give away, damage, destroy, hide, or permit any other person to obtain legal rights in any property, whether real estate or personal property, owned or possessed by the parties together (or solely by the other party if the parties are married), except in the usual course of business or for the necessities of life.
8. The Dakota County Sheriff's department and the Inver Grove Heights Police Department shall help the Petitioner execute and/or serve this Order, without charge. Peace officers licensed by the State of Minnesota and correction officers, including, but not limited to, probation officers, court services officers, parole officers and employees of jails or correctional facilities may serve an Order for Protection. If the application for relief is brought in a county in which the Respondent is not present, the sheriff shall forward the pleadings necessary for service upon the Respondent to the sheriff of the county in which the Respondent is present. This must be expedited to allow for timely service.

9. Under federal law, every Police Department and Sheriffs office in the United States, including Washington D.C. and tribal and territorial lands, is responsible for enforcing this order. Enforcement of this order may include, but is not limited to, assisting in obtaining physical custody of child(ren), removing Respondent from the residence, and getting property back from the Respondent. 18 U.S.C. 2265.
10. You are also restrained from harassing, stalking, or threatening the Protected Person(s), or engaging in other conduct that would place the Protected Person(s) in reasonable fear of bodily injury to that person; and you are prohibited from the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force against the Protected Person(s) that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury. 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(8)(B) and (C).
11. This Order will be effective for a period of seven days from the date of this order.

Notice to Respondent:

- **You have a right to a hearing. If no hearing is scheduled and you want a hearing, you must request one within 5 days of service of this order by completing and returning the "Request for Hearing" form to court administration.**
- **A police officer shall arrest you and take you to jail if the police officer believes you have violated this Order and shall hold you in jail for at least 36 hours excluding the day of arrest, Sundays, and holidays, unless you are released by a judge or judicial officer.**
- **Violation of this Order may be treated as a misdemeanor, gross misdemeanor, or felony. A misdemeanor violation may result in a sentence of up to 90 days in jail and/or a fine of up to \$1,000. Some repeat violations are gross misdemeanors that may result in a sentence of up to one year in jail and/or a fine up to \$3,000. Other violations are felonies and may result in a sentence of imprisonment for up to five years and/or a fine of up to \$10,000.**
- **This order is entitled to full faith and credit and shall be enforced anywhere in the U.S. including Tribal lands. 18 U.S.C. § 2265. Crossing state, territorial, or tribal boundaries to violate this order may result in federal imprisonment. 18 U.S.C. § 2262.**
- **A violation of this Order for Protection is a deportable offense. If you are not a United States citizen, a violation of this Order could result in your deportation.**
- **You must comply with the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(8), concerning the shipping, transporting, possession, or receiving of firearms and ammunition when a qualifying protective order is in place.**

Notice to Petitioner

- **If you move, notify the Court Administrator so that your address can be updated for notice and enforcement purposes.**
- **If you move to a different city, send or deliver a copy of the Order for Protection to law enforcement for your new city.**

- Your Order for Protection will be enforced even if you fail to take the steps above.

Notice to Both Parties:

If a hearing is scheduled, be prepared on the scheduled date. You may be asked to testify at that time, or depending on the Court's calendar, the hearing may be rescheduled. You should bring any available documentation, such as police reports (certified copies), hospital and doctor reports, pictures, witnesses, or other items. You may not be able to use written reports, affidavits, or statements from persons who are not at the hearing as witnesses.

NOTE: If an Order for Protection is issued, the Court must consider the Order in making a decision in any parenting time (visitation) proceeding, if requested by Petitioner.

NOTE: When signed by a Referee, this temporary order is effective upon the Referee's signature (Minn. Stat. § 518B.01, subd. 7 (c)).
