THIS IS THE ONLY NOTIFICATION YOU WILL RECEIVE REGARDING YOUR PERSONAL PROPERTY LEFT AT THE DAKOTA COUNTY JAIL.

All Inmates:

It is your responsibility to arrange for all your personal property left at the Dakota County Jail to be picked up within 90 days of the date of your release/transfer. Property not picked up within 90 days will be considered abandoned and Jail staff will dispose, donate or sell the property in compliance with Minnesota law. You may authorize release of your property to other individual(s) within this 90 day period. If you choose to do this, you must complete the Release Authorization for Retrieval of Property designating the individual(s) that you authorize to retrieve your property. When that individual picks up your property at the Jail, they must have a current picture ID to show Jail staff.

Transferred Inmates:

The Dakota County Jail does NOT transfer any of your property to your next facility, except your legal materials. A copy of this Notification is provided to you to take with you to your next facility.


MN Department of Corrections Inmates:

Inmates who are transferred to facilities operated by the Minnesota Department of Corrections need to be aware that they will only be allowed to have the following personal items with them at the State facility:

- One pair prescription eyeglasses
- One address book (no metal)
- Legal materials
- Money
- Twenty photographs (polaroids, albumns, gang-related or sexually explicit photographs are not allowed)
- One plain wedding band (no stones)
- Medications
- Religious items
- Identification documents
