This Yellow Belt course gives you a solid, practical introduction to Lean Six Sigma. Across two focused days, you'll learn how to see waste, map and understand processes, and contribute confidently to improvement projects in your area. The programme blends core Lean tools with introductory Six Sigma concepts, so you leave with a common language for problem-solving and continuous improvement.

- Understand the basic DMAIC framework and how Yellow Belts contribute to projects
