
### AP Course Ledger

The AP Course Ledger lists accredited brick and mortar schools, and/or those sanctioned by their state education agency, that are authorized to use the AP<sup>®</sup> designation on student transcripts, in course catalogs, and on school websites.

Accredited organizations, which can issue school transcripts and diplomas, will have their eligible AP courses listed on the AP Course Ledger under that organization's respective name. Non-accredited organizations must have their eligible AP courses selected by an accredited brick and mortar school in their AP Course Audit account to be listed in the AP Course Ledger along with their organization's name.
