In June of 2021, he will be a commissioned elder in the UMC, having a personal mission of adapting and innovating churches to meet the changing realities of the world.

In 2015, he was selected to participate in the Central Cohort of the Courage to Lead for Young United Methodist ministers. In 2016, he graduated from Asbury Theological Seminary. In 2018, he completed an Ethics Fellowship as a Resident Chaplain at the Charles Warren Fairbanks Center for Medical Ethics at Indiana University Hospital, completing a research project studying patient spirituality.

## **Senior Dinners**




