## **Festivals & Sporting Events**



Going to a festival or outdoor event is a great adventure, and staying in a motorhome will give you all the creature comforts! Please see below, some hints and tips we have put together to make your stay more enjoyable:

- Try to think ahead and plan your trip you will not be able to leave site once you
  have arrived.
- Fill your fresh water tank fully, and remember the tank does not hold a limitless supply! You will not be able to drive to a tap to "top-up" your tank once you have parked. Where possible, use the facilities on site to ensure your water lasts. We can provide you with a water carrier and hose / connector if you would like (extra charge), if you think you will need extra fresh water, especially if you want to have a shower every day.
- You will probably not have access to chemical toilet emptying facilities during your stay. Your waste water tank should last you a few days, but try to make use of the toilet facilities on site when at the event to give you plenty of time and avoid any problems.
- Food you will not be able to go out to shops, and there may be limited items
  available on site. Fill your fridge with the essentials before you set off and remember
  to get your fridge down to temperature using the gas setting before you leave home
  (quickest and most efficient way to get your fridge to the correct temperature).
   Travel using the battery setting to keep the contents cool and then put it back onto
  gas when you park up on site to conserve your leisure battery.
- Please leave all blinds closed when you leave the motorhome and remember to lock the vehicle and all lockers and the habitation door.
- Please do not attach anything to the outside of the vehicle!
- It is highly unlikely that you will have access to an electric hook-up on site. Some of
  our motorhomes have a solar panel fitted that will charge the leisure battery. Our
  van conversion does not have a solar panel and will be dependent on its leisure
  battery. Starting the motorhome and running it briefly each morning should charge
  the leisure battery. Think carefully about how you use the appliances in the vehicles
  to spread the load and charge of your battery. Use the gas setting for your fridge and
  heater if required.
- Remember to take a 12V car-charger cable to charge your phones and other gadgets

   you will find this really useful and there will not be any electric sockets on site to
   charge them otherwise
- Mud, glorious mud! Festivals and mud seem to go together but please keep wellies outside, and carry them in bags inside!
- Please remember, everyone who is travelling with you will need a festival or event ticket.
