## 13. Government Funding

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### 13.1 Government Funding: Entitlement

We accept all forms of government funding.

Eligible Families can access:

- 9 month old EYFE for Working Families up to 30 hours.
- 2 year old EYFE for Working Families up to 30 hours.
- 2 year old Local Authority (LA) Issued EYFE up to 15 hours (Apply online at [westsussex.gov.uk/ FundedChildcare](http://westsussex.gov.uk/FundedChildcare))
- 3 and 4 year old Working Families EYFE up to 30 hours

All children can access:

- 3 and 4 year old Universal EYFE up to 15 hours

### 13.2 Government Funding: Pattern of Delivery

Examples of how the funding can be used at Milland Valley Nursery School:

15 hours	30 hours
6 hours over 2 days and 3 hours over one day = 15 hours	6 hours over 4 days = 24 hours
3 hours over 4 days = 12 hours of	
4 hours over 3 days and 3 hours over 1 day = 15 hours	



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We are only open for 24 hours a week. Families are aware that they can use non used hours else-where.

### **13.3 Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)**

We are committed to ensuring that all children have access to our nursery and provisions.

Milland Valley Nursery School ensures that the teaching, learning and experiences in our setting meet the individual needs of ALL our children. Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) will be spent according to the individual needs of the children.

When we identify children who require some additional support in their development our setting will make additional provisions to assist those children.

Including:

1. Additional training, as required, to help extend children's development.
2. New resources to support activities.
3. Any extra food/self-care equipment that may be required such as nappies/wipes.

Impact:

- Children's progress in their development will be recorded and monitored on the child's Tapestry Learning Journal, identifying success and highlighting areas that may need more support.

### **13.4 Disability Access Fund (DAF)**

Milland Valley nursery School is committed to working along side the Local Authority to ensure that we provide suitable provision for children with disabilities.



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We identify children with additional learning needs by asking for any health concerns, and additional information for parents/carers. This space can be used to disclose any concerns or disabilities that their child may have during registration. Any details given will be treated in the strictest of confidence. During the children's time in our setting we observe, monitor and discuss with parents/carers any concerns we may have.

If additional funding is received it will allow us to make additional provisions such as:

- Purchase resources that will help children to learn and develop and be comfortable
- Additional training for staff
