13. Government Funding

We accept all forms of government funding.

Government funding currently provides a maximum of 15 hours per week for eligible working families for 2 year olds and Local authority authorised families.

Government funding currently provides for a maximum 15 hours per week, for a period of 38 weeks per year for 3-5 year olds. Children are eligible for FE the term after their 3rd birthday.

Extended funding, up to 30 hours is also available for eligible families.

13.1 Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)

We are committed to ensuring that all children have access to our nursery and provisions.

Milland Valley Nursery School ensures that the teaching, learning and experiences in our setting meet the individual needs of ALL our children. Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) will be spent according to the individual needs of the children.

When we identify children who require some additional support in their development our setting will make additional provisions to assist those children.

Including:

- Providing additional staff/assistants support during small group work and during key situations.
- 2. Additional training, as required, to help extend children's development.
- 3. New resources to support activities.

Impact:

 Children's progress in their development will be recorded and monitored on the child's Tapestry Learning Journal, identifying success and highlighting areas that may need more support.

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13.2 Disability Access Fund (DAF)

Milland Valley nursery School is committed to working along side the Local Authority to ensure that we provide suitable provision for children with disabilities.

We identify children with additional learning needs by asking for any health concerns, and additional information for parents/carers. This space can be used to disclose any concerns or disabilities that their child may have during registration. Any details given will be treated in the strictest of confidence. During the children's time in our setting we observe, monitor and discuss with parents/carers any concerns we may have.

If additional funding is received it will allow us to make additional provisions such as:

- Purchase resources that will help children to learn and develop and be comfortable
- Additional training for staff
- Providing additional staff to support the individual child to aid 1:1 care, and attention to individual unique needs
