Identifying Goods, Managing Risks

Amongst the most difficult elements when it comes to trade-based sanctions and export control is identifying goods and risks and then managing these.

- Understanding the importance of identifying goods accurately and establishing if controls apply
- † Considering risks such as: Geographical, Terrorism, and WMD Proliferation.
- † Transit and Transhipment risks

Sectoral Concerns

Specific sectors carry particular risks, vunerabilities and nuances. These often impact how sanctions and export controls are managed.

- Logistics and the Maritime space
- the Common High Priority List
