#### Iran

27/2/2024: In a coordinated effort with US, the UK has sanctioned two individuals and three organisations under the Iran Sanctions Regime for their role in providing financial and military support to the Houthis and undermining reginal stability. Those sanctioned include organisations, Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps Quds Force (IRGC-QF) Unit 190, IRGC-QF Unit 6000, IRGC-QF Unit 340 and individuals, Mohammad Reza Fallahzadeh and Sa'id Al-Jamal.

#### Yemen

27/2/2024: In a coordinated effort with the US, the UK has sanctioned a Houthi security minister under the Yemen regime for threatening the peace, security and stability of Yemen by supporting attacks against shipping in the Red Sea. The individual designated is Al Hussein Badr Al Din Al-Houthi.



#### Russia

28/2/2024: The UK government has made one administrative amendment to the Ilya Borisovish Brodsky entry under the Russia sanctions regime. This individual still remains subject to an Asset Freeze, Travel Ban, Trust Services and Transport Sanctions. 1/3/2024: The entry Vladimir Vladimirovich Mikheychik has been corrected under the Russian financial sanctions regime and remains subject to an asset freeze and trust services sanctions.



28/2/2024: The UK has made an administrative amendment to the Ahmad Mahmood Hassan entry under the DRC sanctions regime. Hassan is still subject to an asset freeze and travel ban.





#### ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida

1/3/2024: The following entry has been corrected and remains subject to an asset freeze, Khatiba Al-Tawhid Wasl-Jihad (KTJ).
