Iran

29/1/2024: In a coordinated effort with the US, the UK has designated 7 individuals and 1 entity. Those designated include Senior Iranian officials, members of organised criminal gangs who collaborate with the Iranian regime and those affiliated with efforts to undermine, silence and disrupt democratic freedoms.

Russia

31/1/2024: There has been one variation to an existing designation. The sanctioned individual is Vladimir Aleksandrovich Dmitrev. Dmitrev remains subject to an asset freeze, travel ban and trust services sanctions. He is now also subject to transport sanctions.
1/2/2024: There was an update in guidance around the Oil Price Cap. The UK government and G7 coalition partners have issued an alert to support governments and strengthen oil price gap compliance and crack down on evasion. The alert includes an overview of key evasion methods and recommendations.



Myanmar

1/2/2024: 4 entities have been sanctioned by the UK government. 2 are state-owned enterprises affiliated with the Myanmar security forces and the other 2 are military divisions involved in the repression of the civilian population and carrying out serious human rights violations. Those sanctioned are the 101st 77th Light Infantry Divisions and Mining Enterprise 1 and 2. In conjunction with these designations, the UK has released a joint statement with 8 countries and the EU, further condemning the regimes continued violence.

Libya

2/2/2024: There has been one variation to the designation of Safia Farkash Al-Barassi. This individual is no longer subject to a UK travel ban. He does still remain under an asset freeze in the UK



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
