

The August long weekend will return to regular long weekend schedule with Breakfast and Bingo being held on the Sunday.


We are excited to bring back our **Corn Roast** on August 6<sup>th</sup> in Riverside Hall. YUM!



# Summer Safety

The best way to have a fun summer is to have a safe summer. Here is a summer safety quicksheet!


## Campfire Safety



- Have a fire ring that creates a barrier between the fire and the surrounding grass.
- Never cut branches or trees from the bush – use the campground firewood.
- Always be at your site when a campfire is lit.
- Fully extinguish the fire before leaving your site or going to bed.
- There should always be an adult on site when a campfire is going.
- Sit at a distance from the fire.
- Use roasting sticks with heat resistance handles. Always ask for help from an adult to remove hot food.
- Do not run or play around the fire.
- It is always a good idea to keep water handy in case a fire.

## Cedar Rail Campground Road Safety

- The speed limit in the Campground is 10 km/hr. We are Camping – no need to rush.
- Do not drive when you have been drinking alcohol.
- Ensure you have lights on your golf cart or bike after dark.
- If you do not have lights, you should not ride your bike after dark.
- Wear a bike helmet.
- Parents should be watching young children when they are walking or biking on the road. Remember to always look both ways when crossing a street.
- Teach your children the safety rules when they are biking. No one needs to bike as fast as possible and not be able to stop safely. Also, please remind them not to bike in front of cars, golf carts or tractors/other vehicles.

## Campfire Treats

Quick and easy treats to make over the campfire!

### Campfire Cones



Waffle cones, fruit, mini marshmallows, chocolate chips, M&Ms, caramels, mini reeces – try something new!

Put items in cone.

Wrap cone in foil.

Place over campfire on grill for 3-5 minutes.

**Carefully** remove from grill, remove foil, enjoy!

### Campfire Cinnamon Roll-Ups

1 pkg crescent dough

1 tsp Cinnamon

¼ cup Sugar


Bamboo skewers

Optional Glaze: ¼ cup powdered sugar and 2-3 tbsp water.  
Mix well.

Soak Bamboo skewers in water for 30 minutes. Dry off.

Mix cinnamon and sugar in small bowl. Separate crescent rolls. Wrap crescent rolls around skewer. Roll in cinnamon sugar. Place on grill, rotating frequently for about 5 minutes or until dough is cooked.

Drizzle with glaze if desired. Eat. Rub Belly. Sigh happily.
