



Recipes and Tidbits

Eric's Favourite Banana Muffins

The perfect breakfast or snack for camping! Super easy, never fail and disappear quick!

2 ripe bananas
½ cup miracle whip/mayonnaise
1 tsp baking powder
¼ tsp salt



½ cup white sugar
1 cup all purpose flour
1 tsp baking soda
½ tsp vanilla extract

Optional: ½-3/4 cup of your favourite add-in: chocolate chips, raisins, chopped nuts, blueberries etc.

Mash bananas with fork. Mix in remaining ingredients and stir well. Fill muffin tins 2/3 full and bake at 350 deg for 18-20 mins until done.

Although I have never tried it, I would assume this batter could also be put in a small loaf pan, with baking time adjusted. I have also tried this substituting gluten free flour (with added xanthum gum) with some success.
