Flea Preparation

*In order to help rid your unit of pests, the following preparations should be made. Please note, if the unit is not properly prepared, it directly hinders the effectiveness of the treatment.

- **No occupants in unit** during treatment, and up to 4 hours after treatment. This is to allow the insecticide to properly dry.
 - Launder or dispose of all pet bedding in HOT water. Also laundry bed linens.
 - Vacuum all carpeting, including along all walls and inside closets. Also vacuum furniture, especially between and under cushions. This should be done the morning of treatment.
- Dispose of vacuum cleaner bag in a trash container **OUTSIDE** of your apartment. If you're vacuum uses a re-usable bag, wash bag in HOT water.
 - Remove ALL pets, AND have them treated by a veterinarian for fleas.
 - Cover fish tanks/aquariums with wet towels and turn off pumps.
 - Remove all items from floor, including toys, pet food, etc.
 - Remove all caged pets before service.
 - DO NOT clean carpet or flooring for at least 2 weeks after treatment
 - Follow up treatment to be scheduled 7 days after initial treatment.

*****ATTENTION: No pets or people can be in the unit during treatment and up to 2 hours after the treatment is completed*****
