After King Herod Agrippa killed John's brother James, he imprisoned Simon Peter and assigned sixteen soldiers to guard him. After the Passover, Herod was going to subject Peter to a public trial. Things were pretty grim for the members of the Jerusalem Church. The night before the trial, the faithful met together at John Mark's home for prayer.

God answered their prayers. The angel of the Lord broke Peter out of jail. Let's join the Biblical narrative in Acts -- Peter finally realized what had happened. "It's really true!" he said to himself. "The Lord has sent his angel and saved me from Herod and from what the Jews were hoping to do to me!" After a little thought, he went to the home of Mary, the mother of John Mark, where many were gathered for prayer. He knocked at the door in the gate, and a servant girl named Rhoda came to open it. When she recognized Peter's voice, she was so overjoyed that, instead of opening the door, she ran back inside and told everyone, "Peter is standing at the door!" "You're out of your mind," they said. When she insisted, they decided, "It must be his angel."

Meanwhile, Peter continued knocking. When they finally went out and opened the door, they were amazed.
